5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved

a. Scope of Work

This ordinance is for the construction of improvements at Johnson-Habitat Park. Improvements include an outdoor classroom, gas fire ring, overlook plaza, environmental play space and urban camping area. Other features include a large concrete jetty for fishing and boating access, trailhead rest areas, interpretive signage, and an internal soft surface trails network. The steep slopes along the river's edge will be graded back to create a more inviting and accessible relationship to the river. The river's edge will be reinforced with riprap and the native wetland and riparian vegetation will be restored.
