5. **General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:** Purchase Order PO-00179671 is for one (1) model 2028 F550 Pierce Skeeter Patrol Unit, one (1) model 2030 Pierce Velocity 100' Ascendant Ladder Truck and three (3) model 2027 Oshkosh Striker Vehicles in the amount of \$12,229,826.00 to support Denver Fire Department (DFD) operations at Denver International Airport (DEN). The Pierce Skeeter and 3 Oshkosh Strikers are replacing aging assets that have reached the end of their useful life due to maintenance costs and parts availability. The average age of these assets is 18 years and will be 20 years by the time the replacements arrive. We are also adding a 2030 Pierce Velocity 100' Ascendant ladder truck to the DFD Fleet.

Vision 100:

Maintaining what we have: The four aging assets require more corrective maintenance due to excessive use and age. This results in additional downtime and excessive labor hours that strain the upkeep of other critical fleet assets. Therefore, it is DEN's recommendation that these units are replaced.

Growing our infrastructure: Due to concourse expansions that will have added gates it was determined by Denver Fire that an additional ladder truck would be needed. Therefore, it is our recommendation to add an additional ladder truck to the fleet to support the expansion at DEN.
