A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a rescission and appropriation in the General Fund, to make a transfer to and appropriation in the Affordable Housing Fund Property Tax and Other Local Revenue Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the Mayor’s 2025 Proposed Budget includes \$12 million for temporary rental and utility assistance (TRUA) to stabilize those at risk of displacement and \$2 million for eviction legal assistance; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to transfer \$8 million from 2024 General Fund savings to the Affordable Housing Special Revenue fund for TRUA use in 2025;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations here to made from the General Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded":
