Each year, the State allocates Jail-Based Behavioral Health Services (JBBS) funds to the Denver Sheriff Department (DSD). The purpose of this request is the annual contract amendment between the DSD and the Colorado Department of Human Services, Behavioral Health Administration, accepting the JBBS funds. This amendment modifies the following exhibits with the most current versions for FY26; (See attached Budget document). The updates reflect the contract extension and renewal with modifications to the annual budget and reporting requirements. The JBBS programs offer substance use as well as transition planning and post-release follow up. Services include Substance Use treatment programs, Mental Health and general case management to assist those individuals with substance use and co-occurring disorders. Contingent upon Council’s approval of this request, DSD will amend contracts with the community providers who support these programs to fund their work for the next year.
