### **Major Projects**

2017 AAPI Listening Session

During this listening session, AAPI service providers will give testimony on those issues/problems they feel are affecting the AAPI community in the Denver/metro area. The results of the listening session will be used to guide the commission's work.

#### #AAPIvisible Showcase

#AAPIvisible is a photo project two years in the making, which is finally culminating in a showcase at Corky Gonzales Library. Through #AAPIvisible, DAAPIC aimed to celebrate the many voices of AAPIs through capturing narratives from AAPI communities to dispel myths, educate, and explore the diverse experiences of the AAPI community.
