Scope of work:

BUSCO, INC. will provide bus transportation to individuals experiencing homelessness daily throughout the term of this contract.

- Busco, Inc, will provide bus transportation to individuals experiencing homelessness daily through the term of this contract using a 54-passenger motor coach. Transports are from designated points of origin to designated destinations and occur every morning and evening.
- Locations are generally located within five (5) miles from central Denver. Starting locations are in central downtown Denver and ending locations are in the vicinity of I-70 and Colorado Boulevard.
- Busco will provide ADA accessible vehicles for individuals in wheelchairs or with other mobility impairments.
- Passenger groups are to be picked up and dropped off within a 3-hour window in the morning and a 3-hour window in the evening daily. The morning route window begins at approximately 6:00 a.m. and evening routes begin at approximately 5:00 p.m.
- Transportation will allow for rider capacity of approximately 200 people in the morning and 300 in the evening.
- All additional routes must be approved by HOST management. Additional routes cannot exceed the allocated budget for the current term of the contract.
- Busco, Inc. must have a contingency plan that includes notification to HOST management, shelter locations and clientele if they cannot run routes and/or routes are running late.
