Sixth Amendment to an Intergovernmental Agreement between City of Aurora and the City of Denver for the development and operation of the Rocky Mountain Fire Academy. The City of Aurora has approved the development of its own fire training facility and will terminate this Agreement upon completion of the new facility anticipated in early 2016.
