13	WHEREAS, Denver Arts and Venues wishes to create the "Colorado Convention Center			
14	Revenue Projects" Fund to account for capital projects at the Colorado Convention Center (CCC)			
15	aimed specifically at generating revenue; and			
16	WHEREAS, said fund will ensure that capital investments are strategically aligned with			
17	initiatives that directly contribute to the growth and sustainability of the CCC's operations; and			
18	WHEREAS, the primary goal of the "CCC Revenue Projects" Fund will be to support projects			
19	that create new revenue streams or enhance existing ones within the CCC, including but is not			
20	limited to renovations, technological upgrades, infrastructure improvements, and the development			
21	of new amenities that attract more events, exhibitions, and conventions; and			
22	WHEREAS, the City requires a new Capital Project Fund and appropriation for this purpose;

27	Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the Grant and Other Money Projects Fund,			
28	Accounting No. 38000, "Colorado Convention Center Revenue Projects" Fund, Accounting No.			
29	38436, for the purpose of accounting for the receipt of expenditure of capital program dollars.			
30	Section 2. Monies received from contract incentive payments, vendors, sponsorships, and			
31	financial agreements, and other sources of program income shall be deposited into the Treasury of			

**Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Colorado Convention Center Revenue Projects" Fund, Accounting No. 38436, to be expended by the Executive Director of Denver Arts and

the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18

Venues. Authorized expenditures for Accounting No. 38436 include capital projects and capital improvements projects that create new revenue streams or enhance existing ones within the CCC. This is a revenue based, non-lapsing fund.

**Section 4.** There is hereby authorized the transfer of cash from the Convention Center Special Revenue Fund (15607) to the Colorado Convention Center Revenue Projects" Fund the amount indicated in the following tabulation:
