EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Background:

In 2020 the Public Art Program began the process to commission a public artwork with funds generated by the development of the National Western Center. This is one of three projects for the NWC campus. A 15-member art selection panel that included community members, an artist, and an art professional, and Councilwoman Candi CdeBaca selected artist Matthew Mazzotta.

Current Request:

Denver Arts & Venues is requesting City Council approval to amend the contract to add an additional \$67,752.00, raising the total contract amount to \$917,752.00. This amendment is necessary due to post-pandemic challenges such as inflation, supply chain disruptions, rising costs of materials and labor, and complexities associated with the project site. The revised scope of work accounts for these external factors, specifically addressing unforeseen site changes requested by the City, including adjustments to fencing and erosion control measures, electrical and utility modifications, concrete sidewalk patching required for electrical trenching, additional trenching for utilities not initially installed by the City, additional time and equipment costs, and modifications to lighting components as directed by the City. These adjustments and additional services reflect essential measures to accommodate conditions beyond the original agreement and ensure the project's successful completion.

Artist Matthew Mazzotta will create a structure for community gatherings and events titled Rising Together. The structure will reference a barn and the act of a "barn-raising." It will provide shade, seating, swings, and a colorful focal point along the riverfront open space. Mazzotta will work with local artist Bimmer Torres to paint a mural on the exterior and interior of the structure's roof. Local fabricators have been identified.

Mazzotta is responsible for designing, engineering, fabrication, transportation, installing artwork, and all other miscellaneous components necessary to complete the commission, including lighting for the art. Stamped engineering drawings by a licensed Colorado engineer are a requirement before fabrication. Local contractors will perform all fabrication and installation.
