The Mayor's Youth Commission (MYC) serves as the primary youth advisory board in the City that is situated to provide insight and guidance on matters pertaining to youth. As Denver works to become a UNICEF designated Child Friendly City and as youth voice becomes a greater emphasis for OCA, it is important to ensure the MYC has the structures in place that allow the body to fully represent the experience of youth in Denver thus elevating the impact the commission can have for the community more broadly.
