I went on to develop my skills as a facilitator by: becoming a counselor in an at-risk youth retreat program called Snowball, spending my summers in college as a YMCA camp counselor, serving as a Resident Assistant for three years at University of Wisconsin-Madison and finally becoming a director of after school programming at the YMCA in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

Recently I volunteered with Dr. Ryan Ross, of Metro State, and several of my cohorts in the Urban Leadership Foundation of Colorado to create a program to get the expungement process started for young men of color with minor offenses on their records. Additionally, I will be working with City Council President, Chris Herndon, this summer as a speaker and facilitator during Northside Leadership Week.




