Business, Workforce & Sustainability

BR12- Extends the Lease Agreement with the US Government for 17,887 sq.
0516 ft. of office space on Concourse A for Transportation Security Administration for another 5 years with two optional 5-year extensions providing \$1,617,108 annually in rental revenue (201102621).

Government & Finance

BR12- Amends the contract with Senter Goldfarb & Rice to add \$350,000 for a
0501 total of \$800,000 for legal services to the City and County of Denver for cases when the City Attorney's Office is precluded from representing the City (CE13018).

BR12- Authorizes a payment of \$537,558.14 to Insight as Oracle's reseller for
0520 database software maintenance, for data collection and management, and extends the contract through August 29, 2013 (EAPPS 0000002462).

Health, Safety, Education & Services

BR12- Changes the name of the Head Start delegate agency from Clayton
0519 Educare to Clayton Early Learning, Trustee, George W. Clayton Trust and transfers all assets, grants, and contracts to same trust (MOEAI-201205670-01).

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

BR12- Approves a \$1,358,329 contract with W.L. Contractors to reconstruct
0521 traffic signals, ramps and sidewalks at 5 major intersections: 1) I-70 east-bound off-ramp and Colorado; 2) I-225 south-bound off-ramp and Tamarac; 3) Alameda and Pecos; 4) Sheridan and Florida; and 5) Hampden and Oneida (201205433).

BR12- Approves a \$1,133,095 contract with Interlock Construction for exterior
0522 and interior renovations, including plumbing, mechanical, electrical and
tenant finishes, to Neighborhood House, 1256 Mariposa, a Better
Denver Bond project in Council District 9 (201206025).

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion. If approved, items are placed on the Mayor-Council agenda the following week. This document outlines the items that were placed on consent agendas this week.
