7	WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes at Article 13 of Title 32 created the "Denver			
8	Metropolitan and Scientific and Cultural Facilities District" and requires that Denver City Council			
9	appoint a "Denver district county cultural council" to determine distribution of 95% of the voted ten			
10	one thousandths of one percent of regular state sales tax known as "Tier III Revenues" collected			
11	within the geographic boundaries of the City and County of Denver; and			
12	WHEREAS, ordinance 288, series of 1996 as amended by ordinance 764, series of 1996			
13	created the Denver cultural council to distribute Denver metropolitan scientific and cultural facilities			
14	district tier III revenues; and			
15	WHEREAS, Denver City Council has determined to repeal the uncodified ordinance and			
16	replace it with a codified new Division 3.5 in Article VIII of Chapter 2 to be entitled "Denver county			
17	cultural council" added to the Revised Municipal Code.			
18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:			
19	Section 1. That ordinance 288, series of 1996 as amended by ordinance 764, series of 1996			
20	be deemed repealed and replaced by a new Division 3.5 to Article VIII of Chapter 2 of the Revised			
21	Municipal Code as follows:			
22	DIVISION 3.5 DENVER COUNTY CULTURAL COUNCIL			
23 24 25 26	Sec. 2-208. Created . The Denver county cultural council is established to determine distribution of 95% of the voted ten one thousandths of one percent of regular state sales tax known as "Tier III Revenues" collected within the geographic boundaries of the City and County of Denver.			
26 27 28	Sec. 2-209. Appointment; membership.			
29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36	(a) The Denver county cultural council shall consist of eleven members appointed by resolution of Denver city council. Eight of the eleven members shall be at-large community representatives to serve staggered terms of two, three, and four years. The remaining three of the eleven members shall serve two year terms and shall be representatives of city-wide organizations or institutions engaged in activities which will complement and further community cultural and scientific interest, one of which shall be from the commission on cultural affairs and two of which shall be as determined by city council.			
37 38	(b) In making appointments city council will give consideration to assure a balance of knowledge and skill including, but not limited to, experience in arts, cultural, scientific, and historical			

- organizations, in art education, in non-profit administration, in grant making and development, and in
 business.
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- 4 (c) The Denver county cultural council shall reflect the geographic, demographic, socioeconomic,
 5 and ethnic diversity and composition of the City and County of Denver.
- 7 (d) The Denver county cultural council shall collectively provide a city-wide perspective, reflecting
 8 a broad range of professional, volunteer, and avocational experience in arts, cultural, scientific, or
 9 historical organizations.
- (e) Each member must be a resident of the City and County of Denver, over the age of twenty one years, not currently a volunteer or paid staff person of an organization applying for tier III
 funding, and willing to disclose any conflict of interest.
- (f) Members will serve without compensation except, upon approval of the director of arts and
 venues Denver, reimbursement may be made for nominal costs incurred for work required by the
 Denver county cultural council.
- 19 Sec. 2-210. Powers and duties.
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- (a) The Denver county cultural council shall institute and promulgate procedures for the
 application, consideration, and determination of distribution for the tier III revenues. The procedures
 shall expressly prohibit any and all discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin,
 gender, age, military status, sexual orientation, marital status, or physical or mental disability.
- (b) The Denver county cultural council may create criteria for the selection of facilities to receive
 tier III revenues, which may include an allowance for the payment or reimbursement of basic
 operations and special project costs, provision for a diversity of participation, and provision for
 participation by new and emerging facilities as well as by stable and established facilities.
- 31 (C) The Denver county cultural council shall distribute tier III revenues only to recipients meeting 32 the requirements of Article 13 of Title 32 of the Colorado Revised Statutes as may be amended from 33 time to time. At the time of passage of this ordinance, the tier III revenues may only be distributed to either non-profit organizations that have a determination letter in effect from the U.S. internal 34 35 revenue service confirming the organization meets the requirements of 26 USC 501(c)(3) and 36 whose primary purpose is to provide for the enlightenment and entertainment of the public through the production, presentation, exhibition, advancement or preservation of art, music, theater, dance, 37 38 zoology, botany, or natural history or to an agency of local government that has such primary 39 purpose. Additionally, at the time of passage of this ordinance, the tier III revenues are required to 40 be distributed by the Denver county cultural council to facilities that have their principal office in the Denver metropolitan scientific and cultural facilities district, and which conduct a majority of their 41 42 activities within the state of Colorado, and which principally benefit the residents of the Denver 43 metropolitan scientific and cultural facilities district.
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(d) The Denver county cultural council shall conduct all meetings subject to and in compliance
 with the requirements of Denver open meetings law set forth in Article III of Chapter 2 of the Revised
 Municipal Code.

(e) The Denver county cultural council shall submit an annual plan to the board of directors of the
 50 Denver metropolitan scientific and cultural facilities district for the distribution of tier III revenues

The Denver county cultural council additionally shall report annually to the Denver city council by December 30 any new policies and procedures utilized in composing its annual plan and policies and procedures that the Denver county cultural council intends to use in constituting its next annual plan.
