5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:

The construction timeline for the Civic Center Park Greek Theater project has been revised to 2025. Denver Parks and Recreation (DPR) is proposing to reallocate \$3,000,000 of existing capital park legacy funds (36050 Parks Legacy Improvement Projects, C7010000 Parks & Recreation Administration Division Control) with reimbursement planned for the 2025 budget.

This reallocation is intended to accelerate the progress of several essential projects. Among these, the expansion of the Rosemond Pickleball courts is critical to address the service gap resulting from the closure of the Eisenhower Park courts and the conversion of the Sloan's Lake courts for tennis. The additional funding will synchronize the construction of the Rosamond Courts with that of the pickleball courts at Lowry Park. Furthermore, the Lincoln/La Alma Park project is in the process of securing significant federal grants for a comprehensive renovation exceeding \$10 million. The funds will also support an expansion of design services to encompass a much larger renovation than initially anticipated. A complete design set greatly improves the competitiveness of the grant application.
