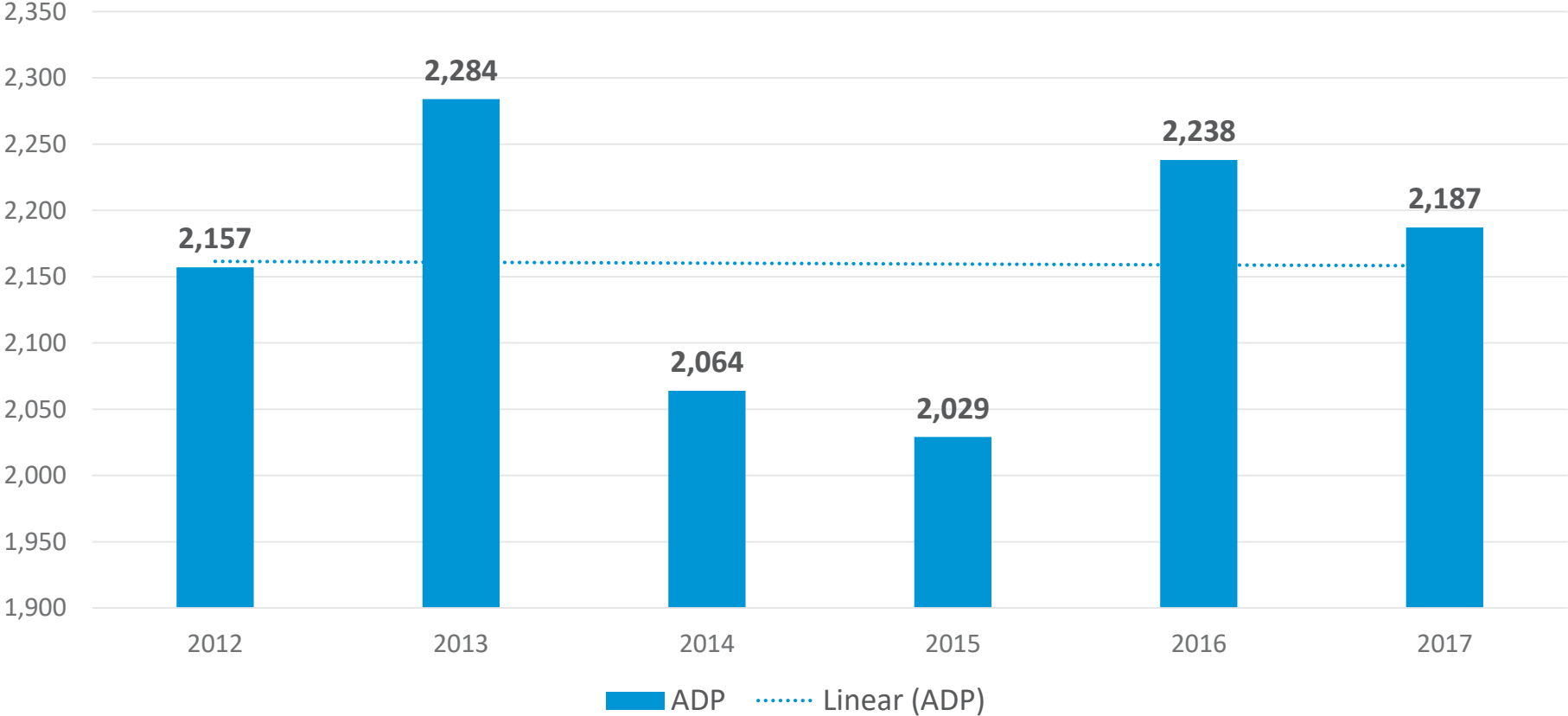

2018 ADP Estimate = 2,110

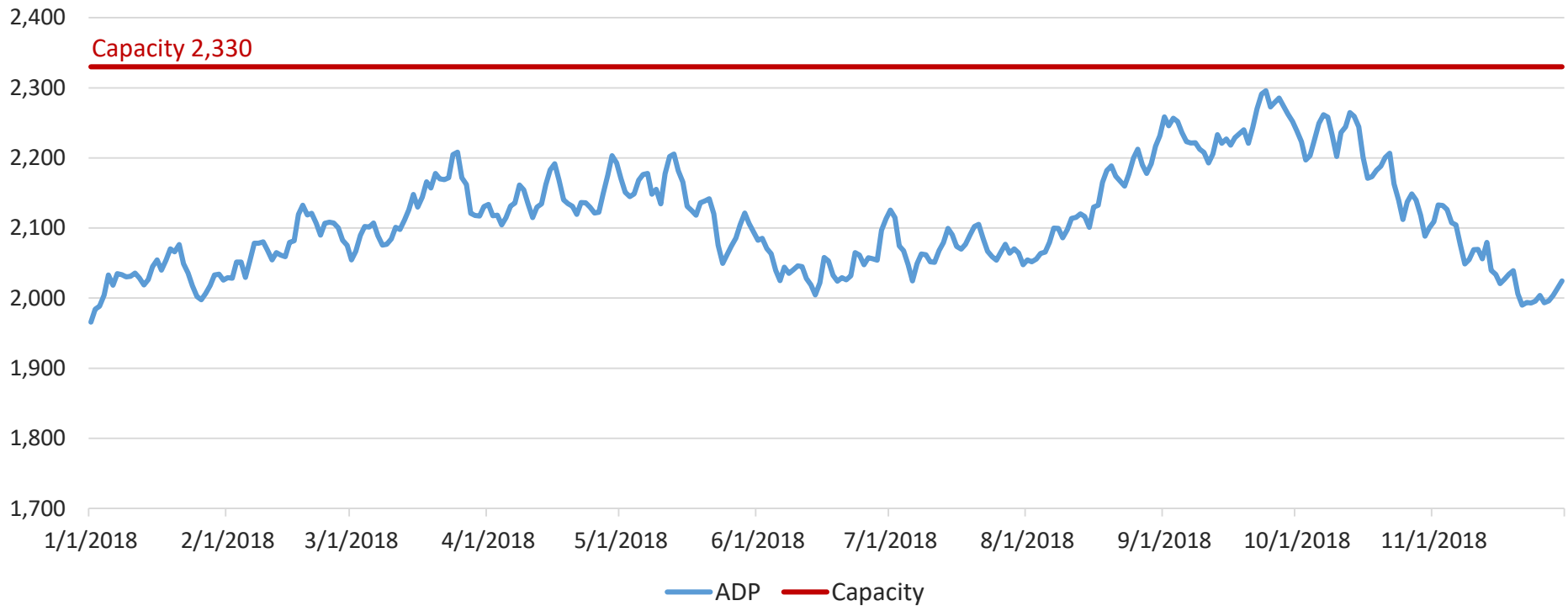
ADP from January thru November 2018 = 2,114

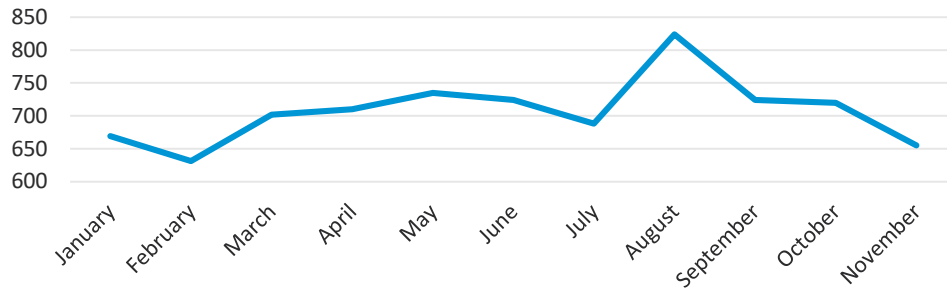

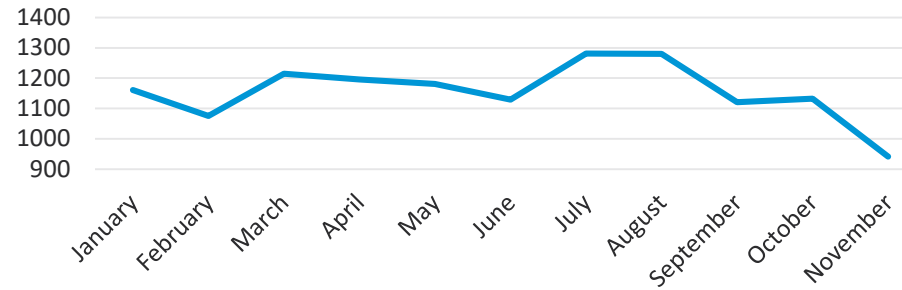

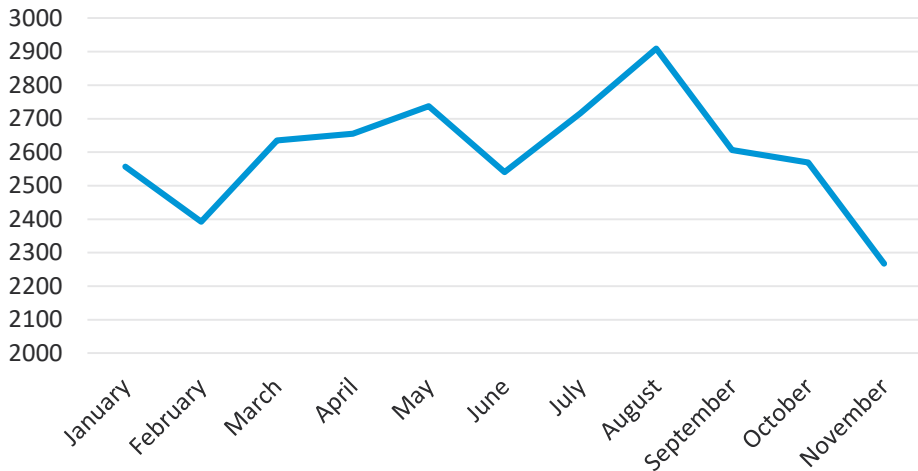
## Felony Arrests by Month



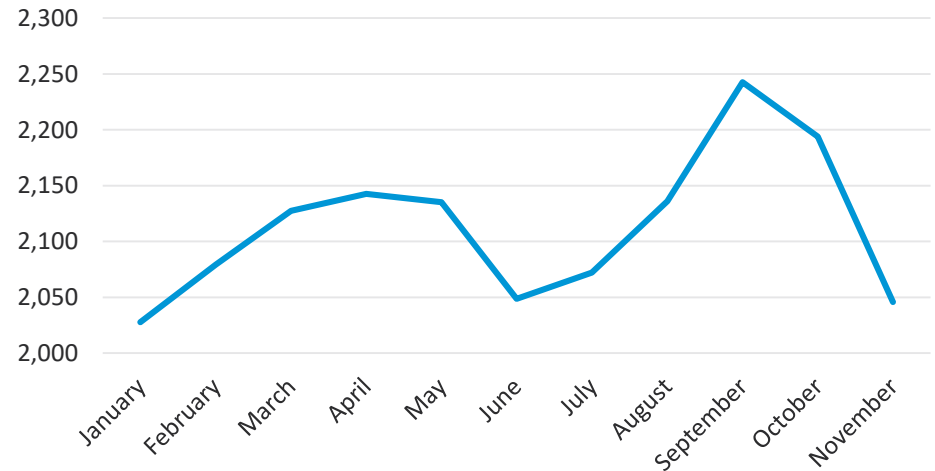
## Warrant Arrests by Month



## In-Custody Arrests by Month



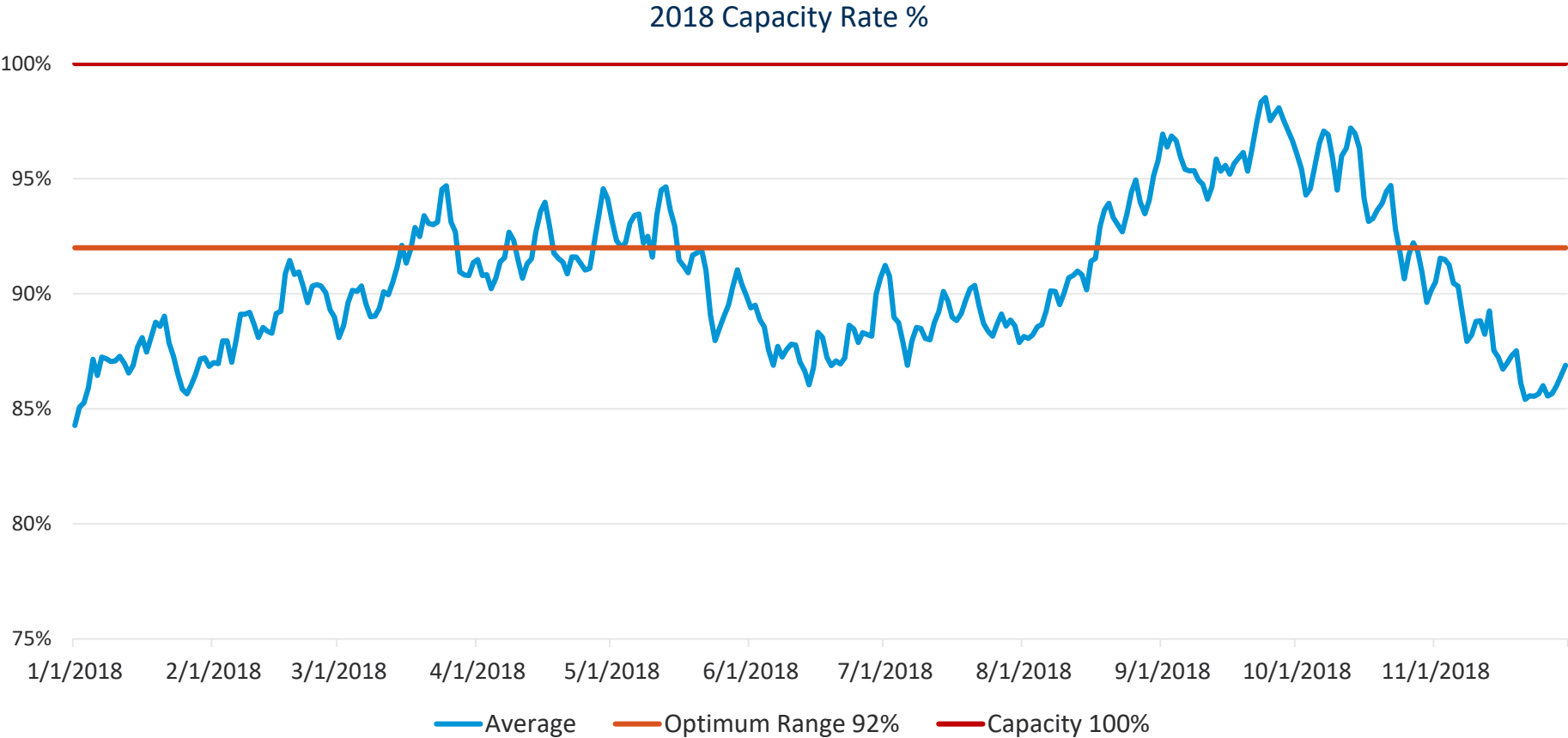
## Jail Population by Month

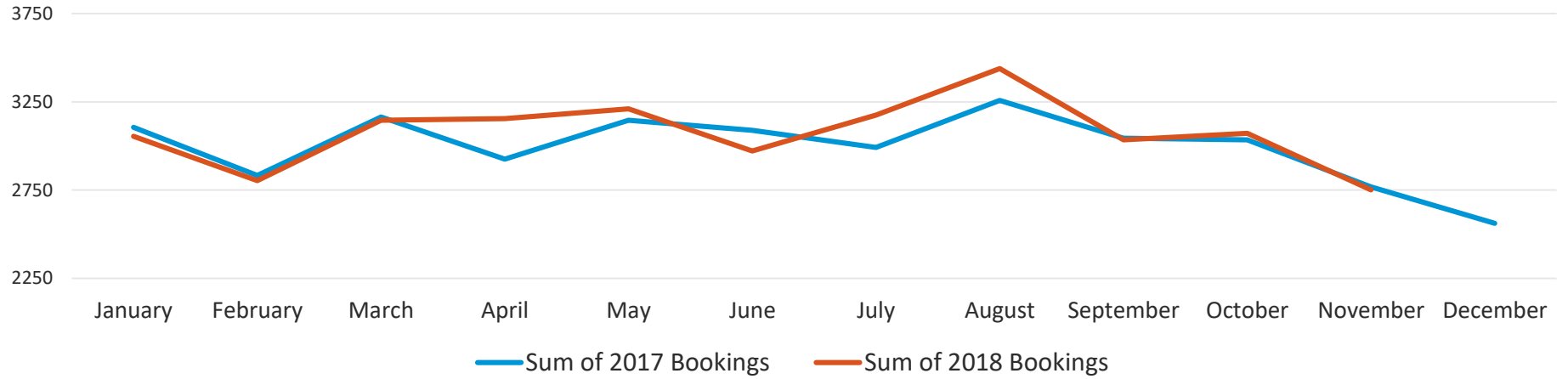

2017 & 2018 Bookings by Month

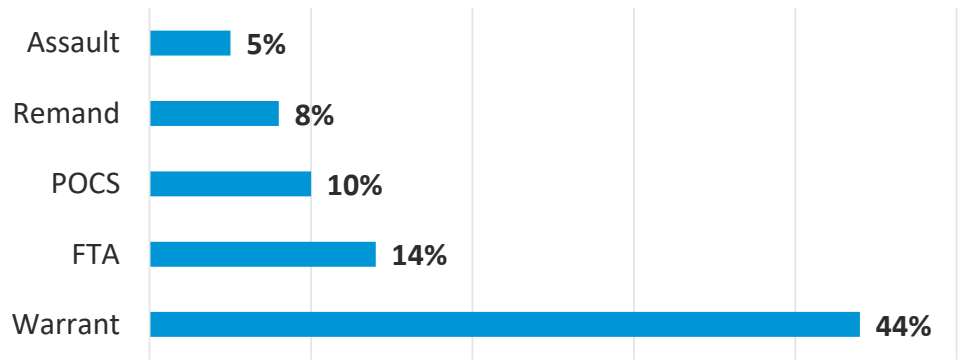


Average 101 Bookings per Day

Wednesday is the Busiest Booking Day

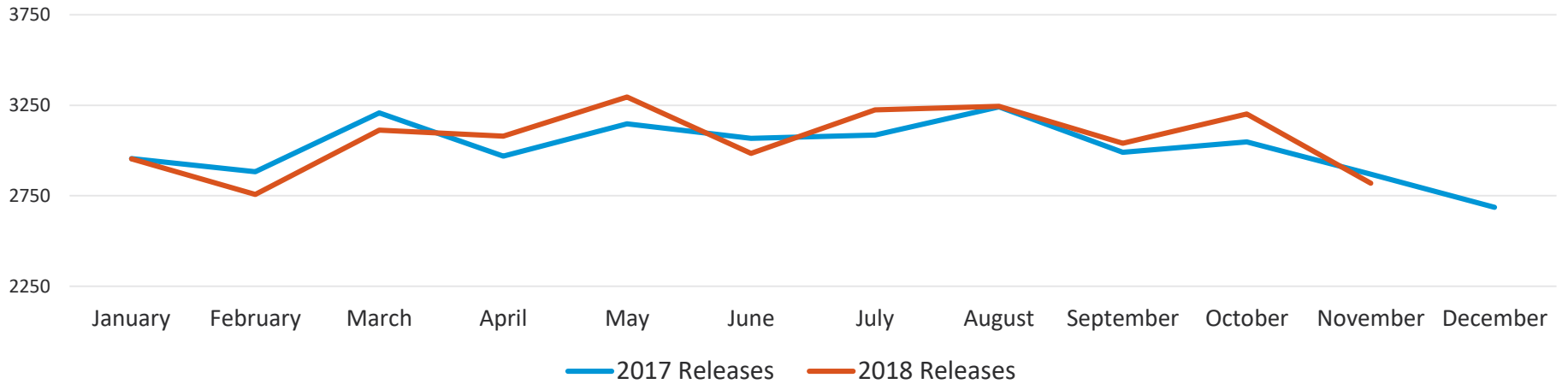
Top 5 Charges - % of Bookings

### 2017 & 2018 Releases by Month

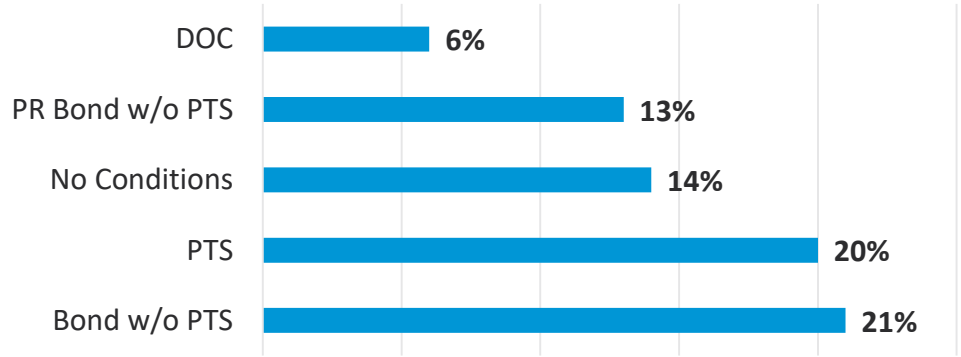


Average 101 Releases per Day

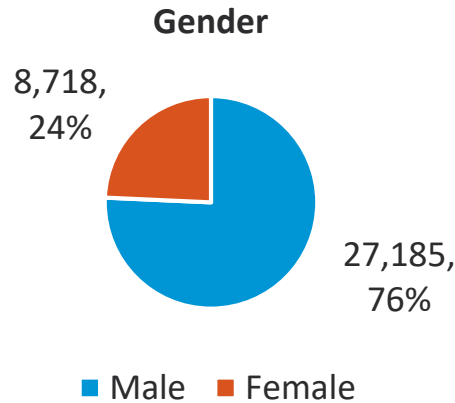

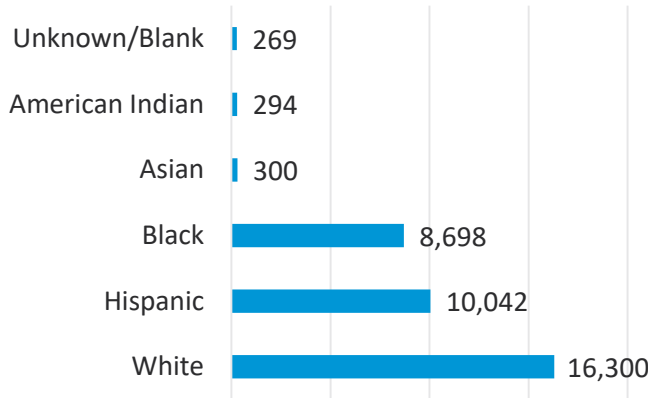

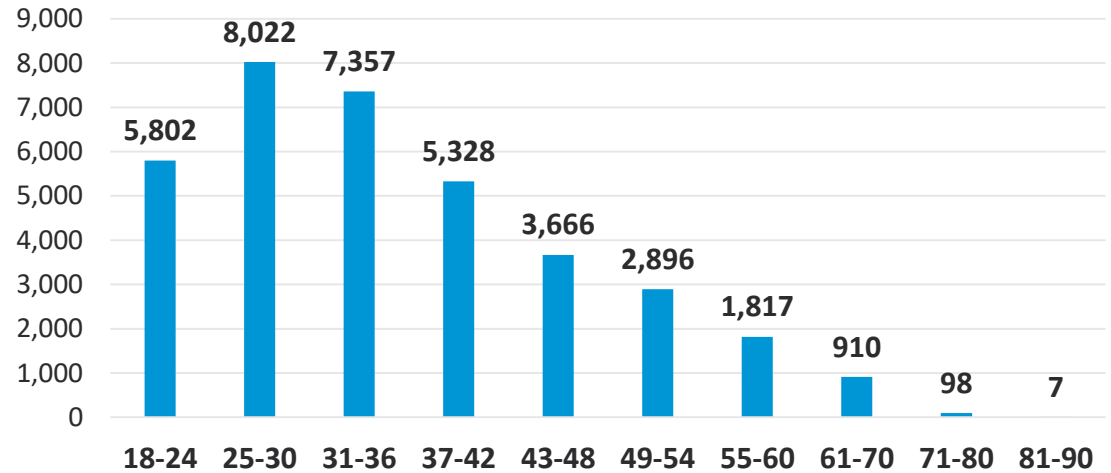

# MENTAL HEALTH

Subjects booked into the Denver Downtown Detention Center are given a behavioral health assessment by the Denver Health contract provider. If the person is assessed to have a risk of suicide/self-harm and/or mental health concerns, the Denver Health provider assigns the appropriate alert to the inmate (summarized below):

## Suicidal Inmates Alerts

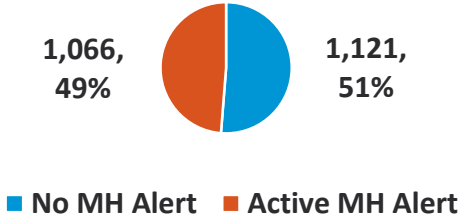
1. **S1:** Acutely suicidal/self-harm patients that have a current extreme risk of suicide or self-harm.
2. **S2:** Acutely suicidal/self-harm patients that have a high risk of suicide or self-harm.

## Mental Health Alerts

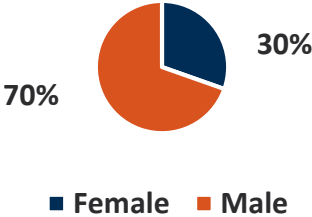
1. **X03A:** Includes psychotic and disorganized mentally ill patients who require intense psychiatric management and treatment
2. **X03B:** These patients are currently exhibiting moderate or severe psychiatric symptoms, including: psychotic symptoms of auditory and other types of hallucinations, paranoia, delusional symptoms, mania, PTSD symptoms, anxiety disorder symptoms, or symptoms consistent with major depression.
3. **X03D:** Symptoms are minimal, absent, or appropriately managed with medication and/or other programming.

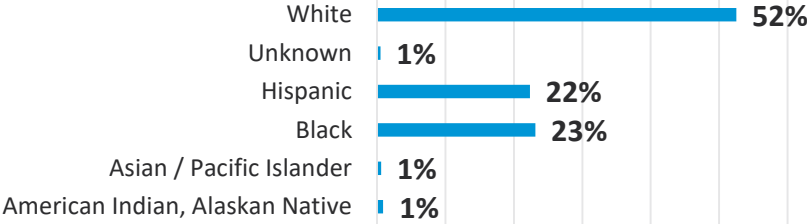

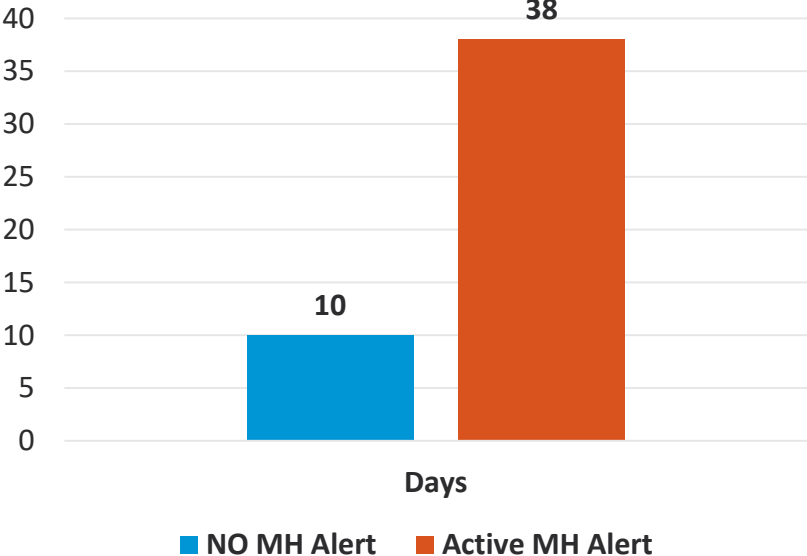
MH Population Gender



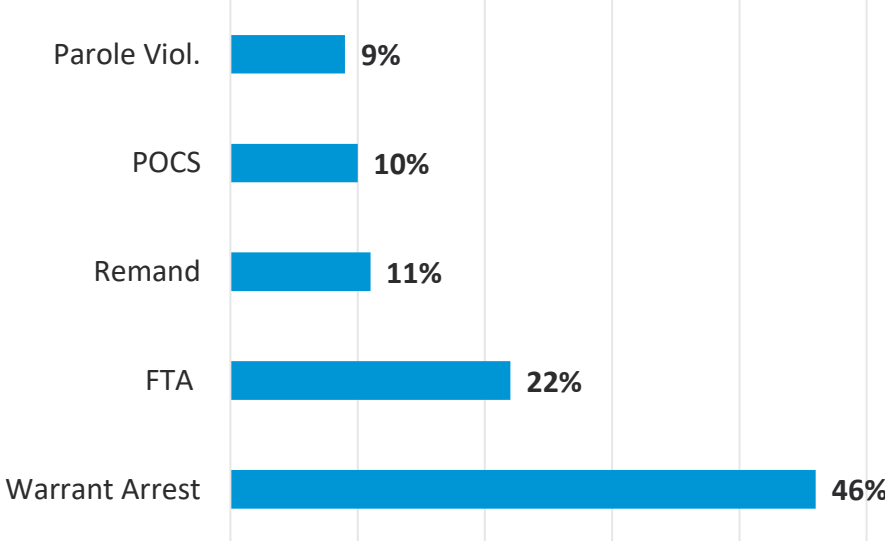
MH Population Race/Ethnicity



Average Length of Stay Comparison

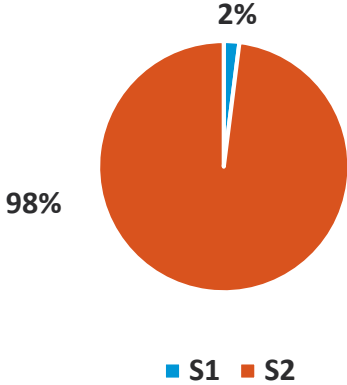


Top 5 Charges - % of MH Bookings

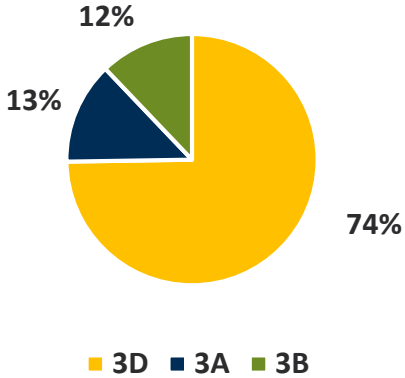

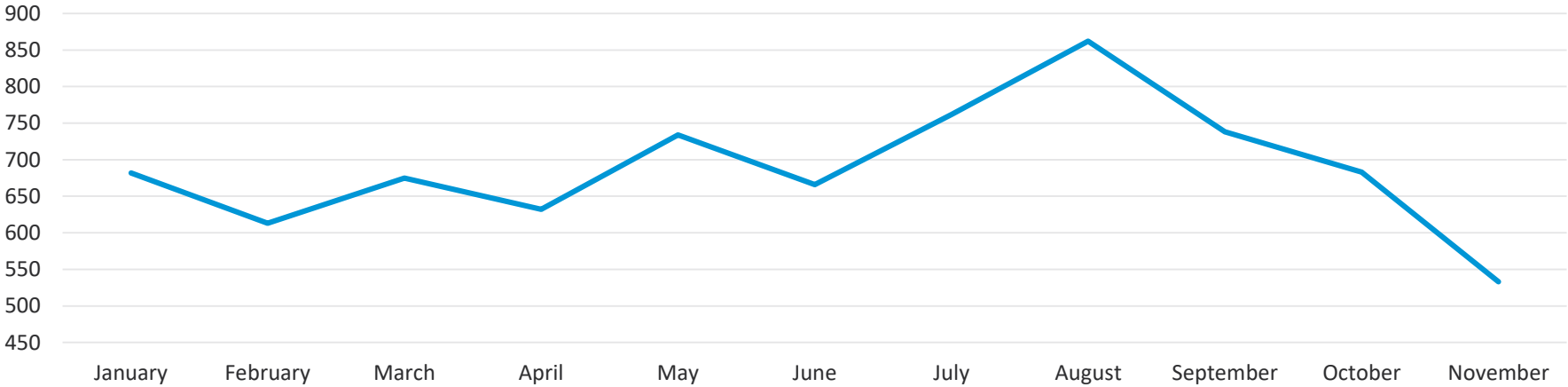

2018 Bookings with An Active Mental Health Alert by Month

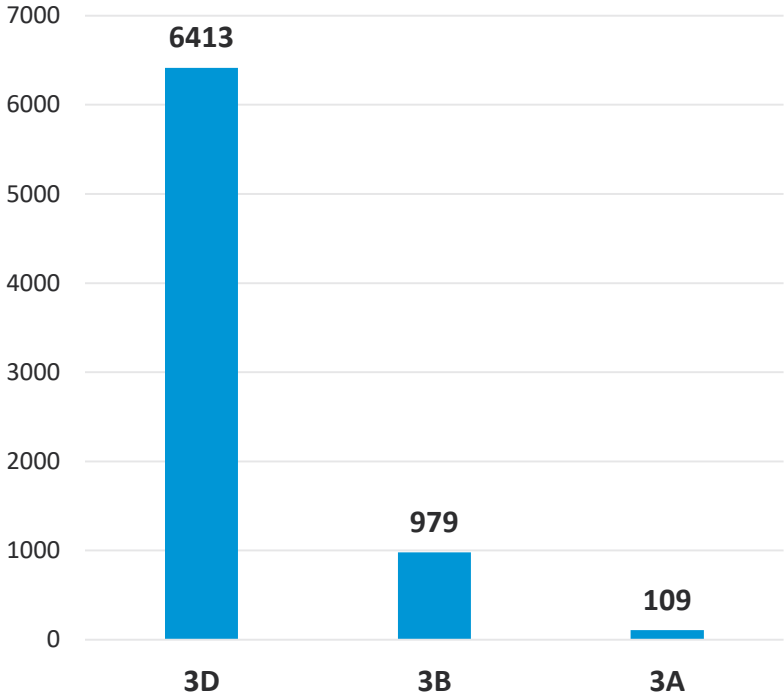

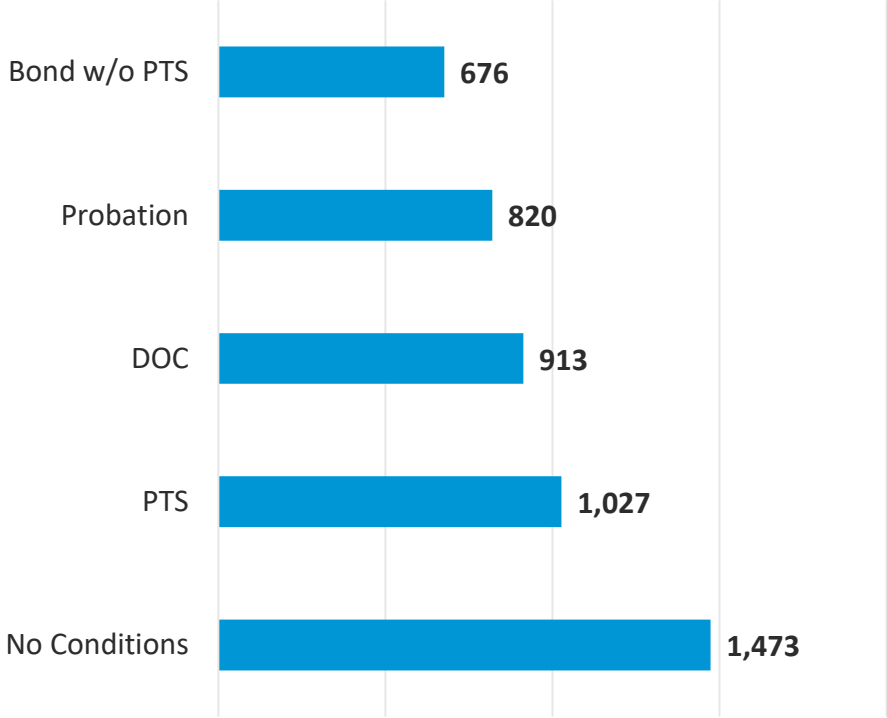
22% (approximately 7,500 inmates) in 2018 have been released with an active Mental Health Alert

### Active MH Alert Releases

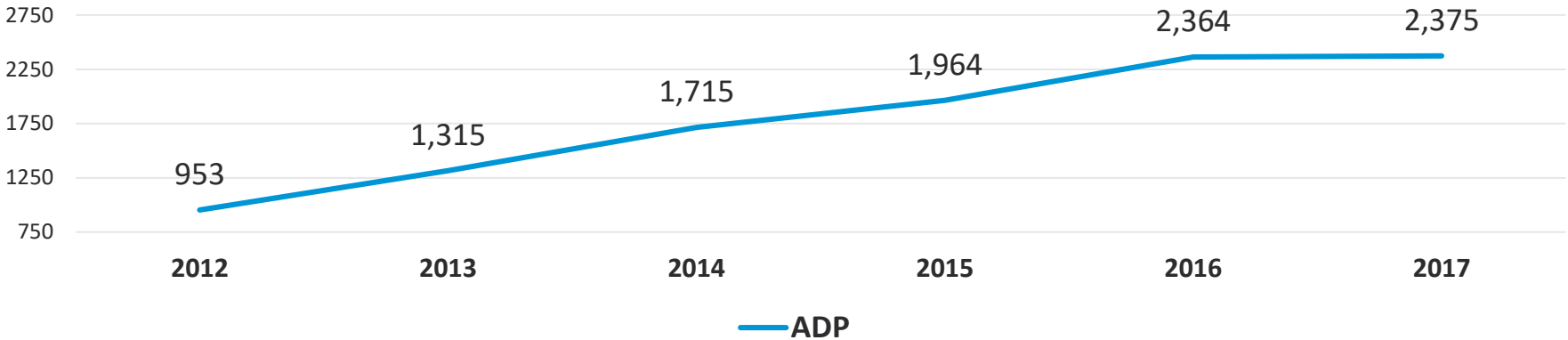


### Top 5 Active MH Alert Reasons

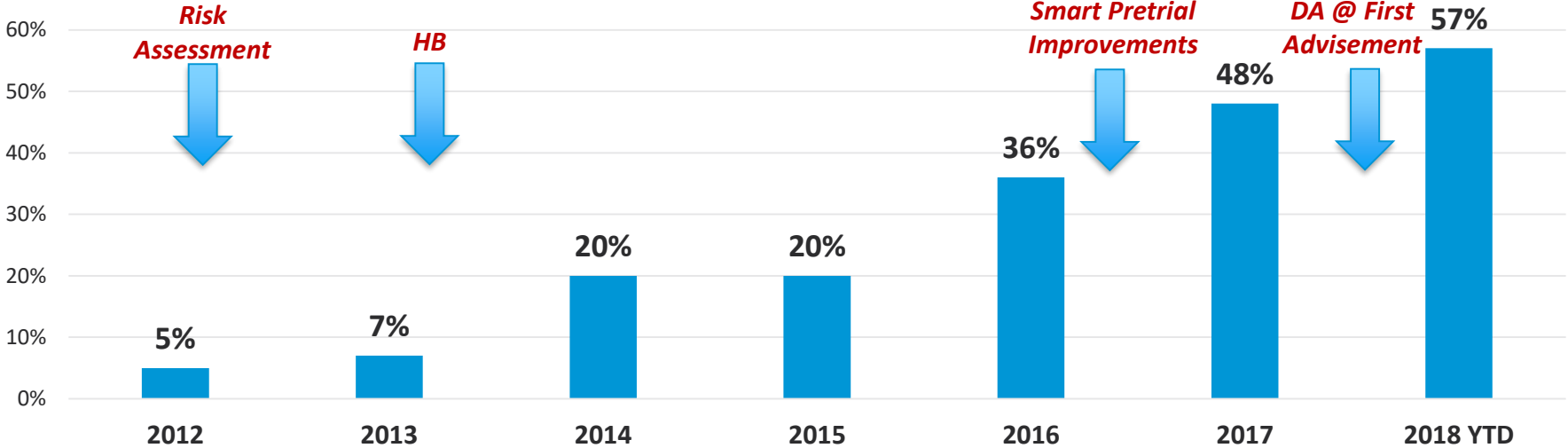
