The compact track loader and associated forestry equipment will be purchased completely with grant funds and will come at no cost to the city. The purchase of this equipment will allow DMP to complete the necessary fire mitigation work outlined in the CO-DNR grant application. Once this grant funded work is completed, this machine may also be used on many other planned forestry/fire mitigation projects in our mountain parks. This machine will help increase the productivity levels on our forest health projects immensely. Overall, the purchase and utilization of this machine will allow DMP to create much healthier and forests that are more resistant to both fire and insect and disease outbreaks.
