FOR AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN ORDER
VACATING A PORTION OF THE ALLEY IN
BLOCK ELEVEN (11), VIADUCT ADDITION
TO DENVER AND ESTABLISHING AN
EXTENSION OF SAID ALLEY.

WHEREAS, T. P. Campbell, Manager of Improvements
and Parks did heretofore make the following Order:

W O R D E R

"It is hereby found and determined that the
public use, convenience and necessity no
longer require,

"that portion of the public alley, 16
feet in width, extending southerly from
the North line of Block Eleven (11),
Viaduct Addition to Denver, to a line
across said alley located five (5) feet
Southerly from the extended North lines
of Lots Nine (9) and Twenty-two (22) in
said Block,

in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado,
and the same is hereby vacated, reserving to the
City and County of Denver, at all times, the right
to construct, maintain and remove sewers, water
pipes and appurtenances, and to authorize the
construction, maintenance and removal of the
same therein, and therefrom, and subject to
the continued right of the owners to maintain
and operate existing electric light and power
lines, telephone lines, gas mains and pipes, and

"WHEREAS, it is also hereby found and determined

that the public use, convenience and necessity require the laying out, opening and establishing as a continuation of the remaining portion of the public alley now located in Block Eleven (11), Viaduct Addition to Denver, in, through, over, upon and so to include all of the land described as follows, to-wit:

"The South Twenty (20) feet of Lot Twenty-two (22), Block Eleven (11), Viaduct Addition to Denver.

"NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said described land be and the same hereby is laid out, opened and established as a public alley.

"The Council of the City and County of Denver is hereby requested to give effect to this Order by the passage of a suitable Ordinance.

"Done at Denver, Colorado, this 9th day of March, A.D., 1949.

 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
 DENVER:

Section 1. That the action of the Manager of Improvements and Parks as set forth in the foregoing Order wherein certain property therein described is vacated subject to specified reservations, and wherein certain property therein described is laid out, opened and established as a public alley, is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 2. In the opinion of the Council this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and

preservation of the public health, convenience, safety and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and final publication.
