This is an annual permit for the extraction of cannabinoids using alcohol/ethanol outside of a licensed marijuana facility. The intent of this permit is to ensure extraction processes are performed safely when performed outside of a licensed marijuana facility, and is not intended to replace any other required permits.

- 1. Any heat or vacuum applied during any portion of the extraction process shall be produced from equipment listed for use with flammable liquids/vapors OR from a source that is non-fuel fired and/or non-electrified.
- 2. A maximum of 32 ounces of alcohol or ethanol may be used during each extraction process.
- 3. All extraction equipment must be used in accordance with manufacturer's listing.
- 4. Annual Denver Fire Department Fire Prevention fire safety inspection is required.
- 5. Heated extraction processes shall be conducted outdoors, unless the equipment is specifically listed for indoor use.
