8 **For an ordinance amending Division 5, Article VI of Chapter 49 of the Revised**  
9 **Municipal Code, delaying the effective date of the Sidewalk Program and Sidewalk**  
10 **Fund.**

12 **WHEREAS**, voters approved the "Denver Deserves Better Sidewalks" initiated ordinance in  
13 November 2022;

14 **WHEREAS**, Denver Charter § 8.3.1(F) grants City Council the power to amend or repeal an  
15 initiated ordinance six months after passage;

16 **WHEREAS**, the ordinance does not require the manager of the Department of Transportation  
17 and Infrastructure to bill and collect the sidewalk service charge by a specified date and the manager  
18 has not started such billing or collection;

19 **WHEREAS**, the intent of this ordinance is to clarify that the manager may not collect the  
20 sidewalk service charge or otherwise implement the ordinance prior to January 1, 2025;

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**  
23 **DENVER:**

24 **Section 1.** That Chapter 49, Article VI, Division 5, shall be amended to read as follows:  
25 **Sec. 49-156. Effective Date.**

26 This division 5 shall be effective ~~July 1, 2024~~ January 1, 2025.
