9 "Urban Areas Security Initiative" Special Revenue Fund budgets.

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11 WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver serves as the regional administrator for the
12 Urban Areas Security (UASI) program, which includes purchasing equipment for other
13 jurisdictions in the Denver Metropolitan Area; and

14 WHEREAS, Arapahoe, Boulder and Jefferson Counties each require specialized equipment
15 to be purchased with UASI funds;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
17 DENVER:

18 Section 1. From the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12100-0160101-
19 S2084, the Mayor, or his duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or
20 acquire the following capital equipment items:

24 S2108, the Mayor, or his duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or
25 acquire the following capital equipment items:

- 26 3 Bomb Robots
- 27 1 Real Time X-Ray System

1 Section 3. The Manager of Finance of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
