 - a. Scope of Work

The ordinance provides for the reallocation of funding, in the amount of \$488,098.97, as identified in the Development Agreement's funding plan, for use in reimbursing costs of roadway construction on the Green Valley Ranch Blvd. Project. The reallocated funds are being used to pay for costs that will be repaid by the Gateway Regional Metropolitan District and the Denver High Point at DIA Metropolitan District. The Town Center Metropolitan District is managing construction.
