### Save the Anderson House Jefferson Park's Most Notable Tie to Colorado History

The House at 2329 Eliot Street is a prime example of Queen Anne architecture, steeped with 19<sup>th</sup> Century Denver History. The Landmark Preservation Commission has scheduled a public hearing on July 7, 2015 to consider its Preservation. Without their certification the home and adjacent bungalow will be demolished and replaced by 18 townhomes 40 feet high. Please consider the following historic events and support Preservation.

One hundred fifteen years ago, a well-respected Town of Highlands resident living at 2329 Eliot shot the two publishers of the Denver Evening Post. William W. Anderson, an attorney, in a dispute over the legal representation of Alferd Packer, pulled out his pistol in a brawl and shot Frederick G. Bonfils and Harry H. Tammen in their downtown Denver Post offices on January 13, 1900.

For those not familiar with Alferd G. Packer, he is known as the man-eating Cannibal of Colorado. He and five prospectors became snowbound in San Juan range in the Colorado Rockies. Packer is the only one who survived the winter. When he stumbled out into the Town of Saguache well fed, he was arrested and found guilty of killing, robbing and eating his companions; the judge was reputed to have charged he ate five of the seven Democrats in Hinsdale County.

This is the story of the rough and tumble frontier days in Denver which made news in every Colorado mining camp and in newspapers from San Francisco to New York for years. The publishers survived, to the chagrin of many. William W. Anderson was tried three times with two hung juries and finally was acquitted the third time in 1901 when it was clear Bonfils and Tammen had attempted to bribe the jury with women, whiskey and \$500. The publishers were indicted for jury tampering but acquitted due to "lack of evidence", for which the judge faced threats of disbarment. As for Alferd Packer he was finally paroled in 1901 by Governor Thomas. He lived out his days as a guard for the Denver Post and passed away in 1907 in Jefferson County.

The house on the hill at 2329 Eliot is historically important to Denver because of the people who owned the home and who lived there. Historic research shows Charles H. Walker, pastor of the Beth-Eden Baptist Church, platted Block 34 on June 10, 1886 and so it is named as his Subdivision. Walker sold Lots 24 & 25 on September 13, 1887 for \$1,000. It is believed the home was constructed about 1888 by Christopher C. Miller during a rapid expansion of streetcar lines to the suburbs. William W. Anderson and family lived in the home during the shooting and while his three trials unfolded in 1900 and 1901. He appears to have been a renter at that time, then moved away only to return in 1915 to purchase the home for \$2,500. During this period he owned homes immediately to the north and south, plus the artesian well in Carriage Lot 37. William W. Anderson, attorney-at-law lived there with his daughter and son-in-law until his death in January 1930.

Architecturally the house is significant as the only remaining intact examples of large two-story Queen Anne-style houses constructed in the Jefferson Park neighborhood. The carriage lot behind was the site of an artesian well once owned by the Town of Highlands. A streetcar line ran past 2329 Eliot, running from what is now west 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, crossing Federal Boulevard, turning left on Eliot and then turning right on 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue to downtown Denver. W.W. Anderson rode the streetcar that January day to his downtown law office in the Cooper Building. Before noon he walked across the street to the *Post* to meet with Bonfils & Tammen in what turned out to be a brawl. Anderson left, then returned with his equalizer .38 Smith & Wesson. Fortunately he was a poor shot.

Walk by the home at 2329 Eliot. You will see a yellow poster advising the Landmark Preservation Commission has scheduled a public hearing for Tuesday July 7, 2015 (LPC Hearing is postponed pending court decision on developer's lawsuit against the City). The current issue of North Denver Tribune explores in-depth, the differing opinions about Preservation. You are encouraged to attend the hearing when it is rescheduled. By Jerry Olson 6/30/2015

### Why Preserve the Historic Anderson House?

### 1. The Anderson House brings to life the frontier west in Denver in 1900

The Anderson House at 2329 Eliot was the home of Denver attorney William W. Anderson who played an important role in the rough-and-tumble, turn-of the-century Denver. He sought to represent Alfred Packer, the Colorado Cannibal and in so doing crossed paths with the outrageous founders of the Denver Post, Harry Tammen and Frederick Bonfils. In a heated argument, the three wound up in fisticuffs over who was to represent Packer and secure his parole from prison. Anderson, belittled and bruised, pulled out his Smith & Weston and shot both Tammen and Bonfils twice. Both lived and Anderson was criticized for being such a poor shot. Anderson was tried twice resulting in hung juries and then was acquitted in his third trial when Harry Tammen among others were indicted and convicted for attempted bribery of the jury with "whiskey, women and \$500". Preserving the last 1880's Queen Anne home in Jefferson Park is important to understanding Denver's historic past. ### 2. The Anderson House is a pristine example of Queen Anne style architecture

The two-story house is an excellent example of Queen Anne style architecture popular in Denver from the 1870's to the 1890's and the last of its kind in Jefferson Park. With its hipped roof and protruding gables, the predominantly brick home rises from a rusticated stone foundation with an arched window and a prominent front gable, which accentuates an asymmetrical façade with a projecting front porch and decorative details painted in different colors. Built in 1886, the architectural style of Anderson House was popular in the Town of Highlands. However, the depression and silver crash of 1893 seemed to change the nature of the neighborhood. Many smaller homes were built and remain today. Today, without Landmark Designation, 2329 Eliot a pristine Queen Anne style home will be demolished. And to reiterate, this is the last remaining home with this style architecture in Jefferson Park.

This home will be reviewed by Denver's Landmark Preservation Commission on Tuesday, October 6, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. in the Webb building. Come to support preservation. ### 3. Demolition of the Anderson House is an irreversible demolition of our history





### Lawsuit over Historic Anderson House Ruled in favor of Preservation

The Denver Post reported on August 18, 2015 that "A Denver district judge (A. Bruce Jones) has rejected a developer's attempt to thwart consideration of historic status for a Jefferson Park house it plans to raze to make way for townhomes." The home in dispute is located at 2329 N. Eliot Street and commonly referred to as the Anderson House.

At issue was whether Community Planning and Development (CPD) erred in issuing a Non-Historic Certificate at 4:18 p.m. on May 28, 2015 while the posting period was still open for receipt of Historic Landmark Designation applications. A Non-Historic Certificate allows demolition. Prior to 7:00 p.m. Councilman-Elect Espinoza and three Jefferson Park neighbors filed an application for Landmark Designation i.e. preservation. Upon counsel with the City Attorney's Office, CPD rescinded the Non-Historic Certificate the next day, May 29th. The Developer's Counsel objected to the rescission of the Certificate and filed suit, but the Judge said they cited "no legal authority supporting a prohibition on rescinding a prematurely issued order, authorization or certificate." The Judge decided in favor of the City, reasoning that the posting period did not end until midnight May 28/29 of 2015. The Landmark Designation application for the Anderson House will now proceed to Denver's Landmark Preservation Commission. were on your way to Cañon City, where you buncoed a poor old man out of \$25. You are a cheapskate and a liar, and I don't want anything more to do with you."

Anderson leapt to his feet. "I don't allow any man to talk to me that way!" he shouted.

What happened next became a matter of heated dispute. Bonfils would later testify that he saw Anderson "move his right hand toward his overcoat pocket," as though reaching for a weapon. Anderson claimed that he was the victim of an unprovoked attack. Whatever the truth of the matter, both agreed that, at that moment, Bonfils jumped up and delivered several blows to the lawyer's face.

"Gentlemen, gentlemen!" cried Pry, rising to her feet. "This won't do! Stop it!"

Snatching up his hat, which had fallen to the floor, Anderson started for the door. "Get out, you damned faker," Tammen shouted after him, "and don't ever come back."

With Bonfils following close behind, Anderson left the Red Room and headed down the hallway for the exit. He later claimed that, just as he reached the outer door, Bonfils kicked him in the seat of his pants. "That was one kick too many," Anderson would testify, "and I let him have it."

Bonfils told a different story. He acknowledged delivering a parting shot to Anderson—not a kick in the pants, however, but a vow to have the lawyer disbarred for cheating Packer out of his money. With that, Anderson "put his right hand down in his overcoat pocket, drew a gun, and fired point blank at me."

The bullet entered the left side of his chest close to the nipple. Bonfils, believing he had been shot through the heart, staggered back into the Red Room and leaned his hands against his desk. An instant later, Anderson appeared in the doorway, took aim with his .38-caliber Smith & Wesson revolver, and shot Bonfils in the back, the bullet passing through his right shoulder blade and lodging in his chest.

As Pry let out a scream, Anderson turned his gun on Tammen, who had rushed to his partner's side. Seeing the pistol aimed at him, Tammen threw up his left arm protectively just as Anderson pulled the

trigger. The bullet entered his forearm, smashing the bone. As Tammen went down, Anderson fired again, hitting him in the left shoulder.

Pry, who had been standing by the closed window, desperately trying to pull it open and shout for help, now threw herself between Anderson and Tammen, who lay moaning on the floor. Kneeling beside him and shielding him with her body, she raised her hands and cried, "For God's sake, Anderson, don't shoot again!" Anderson stood above her, aiming his pistol over her shoulder, as if trying to get another shot off at Tammen. Finally, he lowered the gun and stepped over to the telephone on Bonfils's desk.

"I'll call the police," he said.

"Not the police, a doctor," said Pry. "You've done murder enough!" By then, a crowd of *Post* employees had gathered at the door. Still clutching his smoking revolver, Anderson coolly walked toward them.

"Don't let that man go!" Pry cried. "He's shot Bonfils and Tammen."

No one made a move to stop him. They stepped aside and let him go. He proceeded directly to the office of a doctor named Blair, who tended to the facial injuries inflicted by Bonfils, applying a large piece of adhesive bandage—court plaster, as it was known—to the nasty cut on Anderson's right cheek and three smaller patches to the scratches on the left side of his face.

By then, the police had learned of the shooting. It didn't take them long to locate Anderson, who was still in Blair's office. Taken into custody, Plug Hat was led to the city jail. "He walked jauntily across the street," the *Denver Times* reported, "smiling and evidently rather proud of himself." Word of the shooting had already spread through the city, and as Anderson approached the jail, he was surrounded by a swarm of people: not a lynch mob but a crowd of admirers who were eager to shake his hand.

### **PLUG HAT**

Sometime in late December, Alfred Packer received a letter from a man who expressed his heartfelt sympathies and assured him that, with the right legal representation, he could still win his freedom. The man's name was Charles M. Fegen-Bush.

There were, of course, things about himself that Fegen-Bush didn't reveal in the letter: namely, that he himself had spent time behind bars in the past several years. In 1897, he had been arrested in Denver for a swindle in which he mailed official-looking letters to several hundred individuals, promising them free expensive pocket watches. All they had to do was send \$2.50 for shipping. A sucker who fell for this scam received a neatly wrapped box containing—as the *New York Times* reported—"a toy watch worth a fraction of a cent, nicely packed in salt."

Fegen-Bush was arrested again in October 1900—just a few months before writing to Packer—this time in Chicago for selling \$10,000 worth of stock certificates in a nonexistent gold mine. Jumping bail, he headed back to Colorado, where he promptly got in touch with Packer.

Though he intimated that he was motivated purely by a sense of outrage over Governor Thomas's decision, Fegen-Bush had, of course, ulterior motives. As he later explained, he planned to open a cigar store in Denver and believed he could ensure a steady flow of customers by putting the infamous Man-Eater behind the sales counter. If that didn't

pan out, he thought he might start a dime museum and make Packer the star attraction.<sup>2</sup>

In his letter to Packer, Fegen-Bush went on to say that among his acquaintances was William W. Anderson, "one of the greatest lawyers in Colorado," who would surely be willing to take on the case.<sup>3</sup> Packer wrote back, expressing his gratitude. He then sent a letter to his unflaggingly loyal friend, Duane Hatch, informing him of this latest development.

No sooner had Hatch received Packer's letter than he called on Anderson, who kept an office in the Cooper Building on Seventeenth and Curtis Streets. Nicknamed "Plug Hat" after the black silk topper he sported, Anderson explained that, because Packer's alleged crime had been committed on an Indian reservation, the territorial court that had tried him had no jurisdiction over the case. It might therefore be possible to secure Packer's release on a writ of habeas corpus.<sup>4</sup>

Hatch, who had been in regular contact with Polly Pry, immediately informed her of his conversation with Anderson. Pry paid her own visit to the lawyer, and—having satisfied herself that "there was something in" his idea—she set up a meeting between him and her bosses.

The following day, Wednesday, January 10, Anderson, wearing his trademark headgear, showed up at the *Post* building, where he was ushered into the Red Room, Bonfils and Tammen's garishly painted private office. After hearing Anderson out, Bonfils, despite some reservations, agreed to support the attempt and offered to cover all legal expenses. First, however, he wanted the paper's attorney, I. N. Stevens, to review the plan. Anderson agreed to return the next morning at ten o'clock to confer with Stevens.

He never showed up. After waiting all Thursday morning with growing impatience, Bonfils telephoned Anderson's office and was told by his secretary that her employer was "out of the city." In answer to Bonfils's further inquiries, she revealed that Anderson had left the previous evening on the 7:15 train to Cañon City.<sup>5</sup>

A phone call to Warden Hoyt confirmed that Anderson had shown up at the penitentiary first thing that morning and asked to see Packer. Knowing that the lawyer associated with the likes of the notorious "bunco artist" Fegen-Bush, Bonfils was immediately suspicious. He

shared his concerns with Polly Pry, who agreed to take a trip to Cañon City and investigate the matter.

She left the next day on the afternoon train, arriving at the penitentiary at nine on Friday evening. By then, Packer was asleep. Roused by a guard, he threw on his clothes and was escorted to Hoyt's office, where Pry was waiting.

His story made Pry seethe. "Packer informed me," she later testified, "that Anderson said that he had come on my recommendation, that he was a director of the *Post*, and that the newspaper endorsed him in every way." After years of feeling hoodwinked by lawyers who took his money and failed to deliver on their promises, Packer was leery of the fast-talking Plug Hat. Believing, however, that Anderson had been sent there by Pry and her employers, "he had agreed to everything and signed whatever he was asked to," including a power of attorney that Anderson had prepared in advance. At Anderson's request, Packer also gave him an advance of twenty-five dollars.

Keeping her anger in check, Pry explained to Packer that, far from having the backing of the *Post*, "we did not consider Mr. Anderson competent to manage such a case alone, and that after his misrepresentations, we naturally could have nothing to do with him." She then had Packer sign a letter to Anderson that said, "My employment of you and the authority to represent me in any matter are hereby fully and completely revoked." With the letter tucked away in her handbag, she caught a train at two in the morning and was back in Denver a few minutes past seven thirty on Saturday.<sup>6</sup>

Proceeding directly to the *Post* building, she gave Bonfils a report of her meeting with Packer, showed him the letter, and asked if she "should take it to Anderson or send it by messenger." Bonfils advised her to deliver it by hand. Telephoning Anderson, Pry arranged to see him at his office at ten oʻclock that morning.

Arriving at the appointed time, she knocked on his door and was summoned inside. From behind his desk Anderson greeted her pleasantly and invited her to be seated.

"I have a letter for you," said Pry, handing it across the desk.

After reading it over twice, Anderson looked up at her. "In what way," he asked, "have I misrepresented the facts?"

"Are you a director of the Post?"

"I never said that I was," he replied.

"Did you go to the penitentiary on the recommendation of the Post?"

"I never said that I did."

"But I have just come from the penitentiary," said Pry, "and both Warden Hoyt and Packer said you did."

A flush of anger rising to his cheeks, Anderson explained that, immediately after leaving his meeting with Bonfils and Tammen on Wednesday, he had been called to Cañon City on an urgent business matter and, while there, "thought he might as well see Packer." He had "done nothing underhanded," he insisted, and would like to speak to Bonfils and Tammen in person and straighten things out.

"They are in the office now," said Pry.

Anderson said that he had some pressing business to attend to but would be there at eleven thirty.

Back in the Red Room, Pry told Bonfils that Anderson emphatically denied any wrongdoing. He was eager to clear the air, she said, and intended to come by in an hour.

"I don't see what the point is," said Bonfils. "As far as I'm concerned, the *Post* will have nothing more to do with the man. But all right."

Anderson, wearing a light overcoat and his black silk high hat, arrived promptly at eleven thirty and found Bonfils and Polly waiting in the Red Room. Bonfils, who was working on an account book, motioned him to a chair beneath a window. A moment later, Tammen entered and seated himself behind his desk, facing the lawyer.

"Anderson," said Tammen without preliminaries, "I want to have a plain talk with you."

"That's just the kind of talk I like," the lawyer replied.

Tammen leaned forward, elbows on his desktop. "Anderson, you came here the other day and talked a lot about professional honor. You agreed to do certain things with us. You made an agreement to come here Thursday morning. Instead, you left, and in an hour's time you

# TWO-FISTED EDITORS

In the early days of America, newspapermen occasionally had to defend their editorial positions with fists or firearms. By the time Bonfils and Tammen came along such frontier ebullience was largely a memory. Yet the partners soon became embroiled in controversies that led to at least one fight in the streets, threats from armed enemies, and a shooting affray in their Red Room office in which they were seriously wounded. This last encounter, incredibly, involved a certified cannibal, a lionhearted sob sister, two hung juries in what had appeared to be a cut-and dried case, a grand-jury investigation, and ultimately a bribery conviction. Bonfils and Tammen, who started as the innocent aggrieved in this instance, abruptly inherited the villain roles to go along with their gunshot wounds.

The episode begins with Alferd Packer, onetime Army scout and mountain guide, whose misfortunes provided one of the more colorful chapters in Colorado history. In the fall of 1873 Packer was hired to guide a party of prospectors from Provo, Utah, to the Los Pinos Indian Agency in the south-central Colorado Rockies, near where gold had been found. Snow fell earlier than expected and Packer lost his way. The party ran out of food. Packer was the only survivor. He walked into the Indian Agency on April 16, 1874, telling a story of hardship, hunger, and death. Investigators who made their way to Packer's camp found unmistakable evidence of cannibalism. It was never made clear whether Packer had killed his companions, whether they had killed each other or simply had died, but Packer confessed he had lived off their flesh. He was sentenced to be hanged. Granted a second trial by a higher court, he was given forty years in the state prison for manslaughter.

Packer had served about fifteen years of his term when Bonfils and Tammen, shortly after they acquired *The Post*, took on his freedom as one of their campaigns. Polly Pry was assigned to write a

series of tear-jerking stories about the kindly old man, unjustly imprisoned, who was living out his life behind bars in Canon City. Early in January, 1900, Polly was approached by a well-known hustler, C. M. Fegen-Bush, who said an attorney named William W. Anderson wanted to talk to her about Packer. As it turned out, Fegen-Bush's angle was that he was planning to start a tobacco stand and Packer would make a first-rate attraction if he could be freed and put in charge of it. Anderson told Polly he had an idea for getting Packer sprung and wanted to talk to Bonfils and Tammen.

Polly arranged the meeting. Anderson explained that Packer's trials had been held in territorial courts although the crime allegedly had been committed on an Indian reservation, which was under federal jurisdiction. He contended Packer could seek his freedom on this technicality. Bonfils replied that the idea was not new, but that he wanted to confer with *The Post*'s attorneys before authorizing Anderson to begin legal action at *Post* expense. Another meeting was set up for the following morning.

Anderson did not keep that appointment. He took the overnight train to Canon City. According to later testimony, he had gone to the penitentiary to inquire about buying some bricks and in the course of his visit asked to see Packer. Anderson told Packer he was a director of *The Denver Post*, promised to see what could be done about getting him released, and accepted twenty-five dollars from Packer as a "docket fee."

Bonfils was furious when he heard about this. He summoned Anderson to the Red Room and, in the presence of Tammen and Polly Pry, harsh words were exchanged. Tammen accused Anderson of going back on his word and shouted, "You are a cheapskate and a liar and I want nothing more to do with you." Bonfils added, "They tried to disbar you for swindling a poor widow out of four hundred and twelve dollars, and *The Post* will see to it that you are disbarred for bunkoing Packer out of the twenty-five dollars."

Anderson, rising from his chair, retorted, "I don't allow any man to talk to me that way."

There is disagreement as to what happened next. Bonfils testified that he thought Anderson was reaching for a pistol and struck the attorney twice with his fist. Anderson said Bonfils leapt at him, grabbed him around the head, and punched his face repeatedly.

Whatever the case, Polly Pry cried, "Gentlemen, gentlemen. Stop it," and succeeded in halting the hostilities for the moment.

Anderson picked up his hat and started out of the office. Tammen

sped his departure with "Now, damn you, get out and never come in here again."

Bonfils trailed Anderson out of the office. "I followed him through the hall to the outer door," he testified in court. "As I opened the door Anderson took two long steps into the outer hall, put his right hand in his overcoat pocket, drew a gun, and fired point-blank at me."

Anderson told a different version in an interview published in *The Denver Republican* the day after the shooting: "I sat there with my legs crossed and my hat in my hands, with no more idea that I was to be attacked than you have that I am going to strike you in the face this minute. Tammen called me a vile name, and I said, 'Look here, Tammen, I won't allow you to talk to me like that.' With that Bonfils caught me around the neck with his arm, getting my head in chancery, and began smashing me in the face. I could not do a thing. Then he and Tammen began pushing and shoving me toward the door. Bonfils kicked me then, and, as I reached the door, he kicked me into the hall. That was one kick too much, and I let him have it. Then I went after Tammen. It was funny to hear him roar."

Anderson had a five-shot, .38-caliber revolver concealed in his overcoat pocket. He fired twice at Bonfils. One bullet entered the left side of his chest near the nipple and coursed through the chest cavity to the right side. The second entered the right shoulder blade, ranging down into the chest. As Bonfils fell, critically wounded, Anderson took after Tammen.

Meanwhile, Polly ran to the window, screaming for help. This is her testimony as to what happened next: "I saw Anderson running down the room. Mr. Tammen raised his hand as if to ward off a blow. Anderson was a few feet away, two or three feet. Anderson was in front of Bonfils' desk. I hadn't moved from the window. Anderson shot Mr. Tammen twice. At the first shot I ran. Mr. Tammen had fallen on his side over the valise. One arm was up. Anderson leaned over and shot at him again. I ran, as I said, between them and threw my hands up, like this [she faced the jury and illustrated the action]. I said: 'For God's sake, Anderson, don't shoot again, please don't.' Anderson had his revolver pointed at Tammen. All this time I was standing in front, following with my body the motions of the revolver, imploring Anderson not to shoot. . . . Then he said, 'I'll call the police.' I said: 'Don't call the police, call a doctor. You've done murder enough.' I looked up; the door was crowded with our men employees of The Post. I examined Mr. Tammen, found where he was shot and left him in the hands of our

proof readers. I went to go to Mr. Bonfils. Just as I got to the hall I saw Anderson and shouted out: 'Don't let that man go—he's shot Bonfils and Tammen.' None of them heeded me; they let him go."

Tammen had been shot in the left arm, shattering the bone, and in the left shoulder. The second bullet went through the body, but his wounds were not as serious as those of Bonfils.

A doctor was summoned. Meanwhile Anderson went to the offices of a physician nearby to have facial cuts and bruises treated. Police officers found him there a short time later. Anderson surrendered his pistol, which still had one live cartridge and four empty shells in it, and accompanied the officers to headquarters. The shooting had occurred too late for *The Post's* editions. The following day, January 14, it reported the attack on its owners in a remarkably restrained manner beginning with a two-column story on the left side of page 1:

# THE SHOOTING OF MESSRS. BONFILS AND TAMMEN

A Plain, Straightforward Story of the Attempt ofW. W. Anderson to Assassinate the Owners of *The Post* 

# HE CAME TO THE OFFICE WITH A PISTOL IN HIS POCKET

Both Men Were Twice Shot, Mr. Tammen Seriously and Mr. Bonfils Dangerously Wounded

The Trouble Grew Out of Anderson's Misrepresentations to Alferd Packer, Whose Pardon *The Post* Has Been Attempting To Secure, That He Was a Director in This Paper and Had Full Authority From It to Act as Packer's Attorney and Work for His Release—When Rebuked He Attempted to Strike Mr. Bonfils and the Tragedy Was the Result—Judge Butler Allowed Anderson to Give Bail and He Was Released—Condition of the Wounded Men.

At noon yesterday a brutal attempt to assassinate Frederick G. Bonfils and H. H. Tammen was made by W. W. Anderson, a lawyer, in the office of *The Post*. At 9 o'clock last evening, when one or both men were in a critical condition, when it was beyond human divination whether they would ever recover and the chances of Mr. Bonfils were balanced to a hair, Judge Butler, behind closed doors at The Denver Athletic Club, admitted the would-be assassin to

bail in the sum of \$10,000, against the vehement protest of the district attorney.

The city had been in a fever heat of excitement all day. The most wild and improbable rumors had floated about on the wings of the wind, to be eagerly snapped up and excitedly discussed, but an array of facts stand out conspicuously. Anderson's name had not been mentioned in the columns of *The Post*, either directly or indirectly. There had been no misunderstanding between Anderson and the owners of *The Post* until Anderson broke faith with them. . . .

Indeed there had been great excitement in Denver. Many, particularly those who had felt *The Post's* lash, were not in the least sorry for its owners. *The Post's* pointed reference to the fact that Anderson had not been mentioned in its columns would indicate that the editors were aware that some of their stories well might invite violence. A number of leading citizens including F. E. Edbrooke, the rifletoting architect who had been criticized by *The Post*, hurried to the police station to offer bond for Anderson. The *Rocky Mountain News*, which had been taking its lumps from *The Post* in their circulation battle, became so disturbed by public reaction to the shooting that it was moved to publish a generous and sobering editorial, portions of which are quoted below:

One of the developments of the Anderson shooting is startling. Almost immediately after its occurrence there was, so far as words went, a strong approval of the act. Scores went to the police station to speak their sympathy to Anderson and give him assurance of support. This, too, without knowledge of all the circumstances which led to the tragedy. It caused Anderson to assume the demeanor of a stage hero and set thoughtful people to wondering whether murder was an approved method with the Denver public for settling personal differences.

Messrs. Bonfils and Tammen publish a newspaper that has established strong public support. It has acquired a large circulation under their management, and its advertising patronage is from the best of Denver merchants and is considerably more than that enjoyed by its evening competitor. It will not do to say, as some malicious hint, that both circulation and advertising has been acquired by terrorizing the public—readers and merchants. If it could be true, it would be a poor compliment, indeed, to the intelligence and independence of Denver and Colorado people.

The fact is, Bonfils and Tammen have made *The Post* a very readable paper. It is wide-awake, and, typographically, a model after which other papers might profitably pattern. It has been aggressive. Here one commences to see the trouble. Its aggressiveness has made it and its publishers enemies. Was it commendable aggression? That will be referred to a little later. . . .

The political fights that Bonfils and Tammen waged were invariably on the side of the people. They were against the greed of Denver corporations, intrenched and fortified with years of uninterrupted sway and the enjoyment of phenomenal profits wrung from a bound and helpless people.

Let the public calmly review these struggles and pass in array the measures and men against and for whom they fought. Stand them out boldly, so that they will cut a cloudless mental vision and note them on memory's pages—public officials who had betrayed in vital public measure their constituencies; public officials who were pledged in honor to resist certain corporate aggressions, and who gave evidence of casting honor aside to accept a corporation's dirty bribes; public officials who were plainly guilty of duplicity and falsehood; public officials who bore the marked visage of the hypocrite and assumed the mask of virtue with which to grossly betray the public; corporations who, with unblushing effrontery, violated contracts, made the public subjects of their extortions; that corrupted electors and hesitated at no crime to carry out their conspiracies every one of them against the public welfare and for their own lawless enrichment. These were the fights they made, and the News wishes this, its opinion, to be carried to them on their beds of suffering—to one of them who, the News fears, is on his bed of death.

The editor who thus fights cannot but make enemies-many enemies, of the strong and influential. These enemies will be found in banks, in brokers' officers, in the rooms of directors. Their influence in manifold and far-reaching. Of such a man they speak with bitterness. Almost praying that their prophecies will be realized, they mutter, "Some one will kill that fellow vet." . . .

Of Bonfils and Tammen this can be said: They spurned bribes that were offered. They would not sell their columns for corporation gold. Does anybody doubt-nobody who knows the facts can-that their support would have been bought over to corporations' schemes, that their opposition might be silenced, if they were in the bribegivers' market? Those for whom they had fought had no bribes to give, they were helpless, even, to help themselves without the support of such fearless men as the stricken publishers.

May not this account in a large part at least for the startling and shameful exhibition of gladness at the tragedy? The hero they would lionize presents a pitiful sight as he, under pretext of representing The Post, induces the prisoner Packer to pay him \$25 of his savings from the monthly pension which the government pays the once brave and loyal Army guide and scout. Going to an interview at which he had no reason to anticipate violence, if he could explain the questionable episode, he arms himself, and when whatever violence there was is ended, he shoots one of his victims down in the hallway and enters a room and pursues the other into a corner, and shoots him down and would have wounded him further but for the brave resistance of a woman.

Bonfils and Tammen have many faults. They have not published an ideal paper. They in many instances violate accepted newspaper ethics. But they are brave men, and in public matters stood mainly for the right. There are many worse men than they who commanded the smiles and approvals of those who rejoice at their misfortunes. They are generous of heart, impulsive and irascible. Many men can be better spared from the community than they.

Such comment was most welcome and perhaps it was not entirely coincidental that later that year *The Post* endorsed Thomas M. Patterson, editor of the *News*, for United States senator. (The editorial supporting Patterson was warmly laudatory. However, he was well qualified, experienced in politics, had the backing of the Democratic party, and no doubt would have been elected without *Post* support. One of his rivals was Thomas J. O'Donnell, who shortly would have his own clashes with *The Post*. The Patterson-*Post* détente was brief, and their sensational falling-out will be related later in this chapter.)

Elsewhere, much of the press regarded the shooting as something of a joke. Said the Washington Post: "In the future the proprietors of The Denver Evening Post will keep an eye on those gentlemen who practice law with a revolver." The Santa Fe New Mexican said: "The Denver Post certainly secured a scoop upon its contemporaries last Saturday when it had a serious shooting affair in its own office. Had not the bullets taken effect its jealous rivals would have been pretty apt to call the affair a fake." The Grand Junction (Colorado) Star, no longer in business: "Bonfils and Tammen have been accused of several bad things, but it is evident they don't carry guns." The Baltimore American: "If the people of Denver keep on shooting editors between meals, that health resort will not be very popular with newspaper men." The Kansas City Times: "That Denver lawyer who tried to slaughter all the proprietors of a newspaper with one revolver found, like the British South African army, that his artillery was insufficient to carry out the extermination contract. If he wanted to stop the publication of the paper he should have demolished the linotype machines and presses with dynamite and then destroyed the printers with a Maxim."

Fortunately for Bonfils and Tammen, infection, which was a major problem with gunshot wounds, did not set in. One of the bullets was removed from Bonfils' side. The other was left in his body. Neither had damaged vital organs. It was touch and go for a while, but in three weeks Bonfils was able to return to his desk, al-

though complete recovery took many months. Tammen's shattered arm was placed in a cast and he, too, was soon back at work.

Anderson was charged with two counts of "assault with intent to commit murder," one against Tammen, the other against Bonfils. It was decided to try the cases separately. The assault on Tammen was set for trial first, in April, three months after the incident. Although it was evident that Anderson's version of events in the Red Room would be challenged by the three other participants—Bonfils, Tammen, and Polly Pry-his attorney chose to plead justifiable selfdefense. In his opening statement the defense attorney charged that Bonfils and Tammen together had attacked Anderson in their office, striking him repeatedly.

"There were a number of them, not the two blows the prosecution talks about," the attorney told the jury. "Tammen struck and split his ear open. Blood poured in rivulets down his face. His shirt was torn and his face was bruised and scratched by those blows. That was the aggression. Anderson was dazed, bloody, and beaten when they called him a cur and ordered him out. They hurled him into the hall, and Bonfils let loose of him and kicked him in the rear.

"Anderson put back his hand and it fell on his gun. He had forgotten that he had it. If he could be beaten without cause like that and kicked and driven like some common hound, it was natural that he should think of the gun. . . . Put yourself in Anderson's place and see what you would have done. What was the limit and why was Anderson called there? Was it not natural with the entire force of employees in the building that Anderson should think that they were liable to murder him?"

Most of the twelve good men and true, described in a Post headline as "An Absolutely Good Jury Without Suggestions From Anybody," shared the attorney's fears. Following a week-long trial the first ballot was 10 to 2 for conviction. Thereafter the jury was deadlocked 6 to 6. Following a day and a half of fruitless deliberations the foreman reported that a decision was impossible. The judge agreed and dismissed the jurors.

The Post's editorial comment was uncharacteristically judicious:

The Post has no criticism to pass upon the members of the jury in the Anderson case; it does not seek to impugn their motives, to cast aspersions upon their honesty or to insinuate that they or any of them may have been biased. Everyone on the jury is well known in the community. They are, with a single exception, long-time residents and all men of substance and standing. Nevertheless, had the circumstances been precisely the same in every respect except the vital one that the shooting occurred in a lawyer's, a doctor's or a merchant's office instead of a newspaper office, is there any doubt, with the array of invincible facts presented during the past week, what the verdict would have been, either from the small jury in the courtroom or the much larger jury on the outside, which forms what is known as public opinion? We think not.

The result at the West Side Courtroom yesterday is not alone of individual importance and significance to the proprietors of *The Post*. It was well and adequately named in the legal indictment as The People against William W. Anderson. The offense committed was not alone against the two individuals who were shot, but against every peaceable and law abiding citizen in the county and state. If there were outrage committed, it was not alone upon its immediate victims, but upon the peace and dignity of the commonwealth. If one man is outraged today and the crime go unpunished, some other inoffensive citizen may have his turn tomorrow. Diffused in widening ripples such conditions degenerate into anarchy. Hence it is that the outrage from which the individual suffers becomes the concern of all people, and the man who fails to secure justice is in the long run no worse off than the rest of the people in the community in which he resides.

This is the calm and impassioned view of the extraordinary trial just closed with such a lame and inconclusive decision by the jury in the West Side court. That decision may be just or it may be unjust; it may have been the result of prejudice or of honest conviction; it may, on the one hand, represent the best and calmest judgment of the soundest citizenship, or on the other the bigotry and narrowness farthest removed from justice; but whatever it may or may not represent, it cannot be ignored that it concerns every citizen of Colorado totally irrespective of his connection with, interest in or bias for or against the parties immediately concerned, and to the people, the great and final jury whose judgment is infallible. . . .

In July, 1901, fifteen months after the first trial, Anderson was tried a second time for the assault on Tammen. Once again the jury was deadlocked 6 to 6. It was dismissed amid rumors that Bonfils and Tammen had tried to bribe some of the jurors. The Denver *Times* finally broke the bribery story. It published affidavits from the six men who had held out for conviction in which they said they had been offered up to five hundred dollars each to vote against Anderson. A grand-jury investigation was ordered.

Anderson went on trial a third time on the same charges late in October, 1901. Although the testimony was virtually identical in all three trials, this time he was quickly acquitted. The District At-

torney promptly dropped charges of assaulting Bonfils, and Anderson walked out of court completely exonerated.

A month later the grand jury indicted Tammen, Police Magistrate W. J. Thomas, Bailiff Robert Schrader, and a fireman, Daniel Sadlier, on charges of attempting to bribe six members of the second Anderson jury. Bonfils was not mentioned. A series of involved legal maneuvers delayed action on the indictments until the whole sorry mess ended abruptly one day in April, 1903, when three of the accused pleaded guilty.

The Times published this story on page 1:

Golden, Colo., April 25—H. H. Tammen, the editor of a disreputable Denver evening newspaper, Robert Schrader and Daniel Sadlier appeared before Judge De France in the district court this morning and pled guilty to the charge of attempting to bribe the Anderson jury. They were sentenced to serve a day in the county jail of the city and county of Denver and pay fines of \$100 each.

Police Magistrate W. J. Thomas of Denver appeared to answer to the same charge and entered a plea of nolo contendere. . . .

Tammen, Schrader, and Sadlier were driven the short distance from Golden to the Denver county jail, booked, locked up, and then released after an hour. Tammen had admitted his guilt, but he was far from contrite. On page 1 of *The Denver Post* of that day he had "A Word to the Public." Describing Anderson's attack on him and Bonfils as a "cowardly, murderous assault, without right and without reason," Tammen wrote:

I at once set about to do what I could to have him legally punished, and I was engaged in that effort from that time until he was acquitted. The law said he was not guilty; my opinion and feelings, however, have not been modified. . . . It would be useless for me to say to the public what I did in connection with the matter. Those who desire will think evil. Those who are my friends will think good. It is sufficient for me to say that I did whatever I could to bring about his conviction, and whatever I did was done because I was prompted by the sincere feeling that he had attempted to murder me, and I had a right to see that he was adequately punished. . . . I simply reiterate that whatever I have done in the matter, whether good or bad, my conscience is clear, for I have sought but one end —justice. . . . I myself have the consciousness that I have done no wrong. .

Thus Tammen revealed a strange aberration, also demonstrated by Bonfils in a later incident. They saw themselves as avenging angels. When frustrated in their efforts to seek redress by conventional means from what they considered to be wrongs, they felt entitled to bring about justice in their own way.

As for Packer, a man-eater in the wilderness but an innocent by-stander in affairs of the more sophisticated urban jungle, he was paroled January 8, 1901. This was just short of a year after Anderson came to see him and pocketed the twenty-five-dollar fee, and six months before Anderson's second trial. He retired to a little shack in Littleton, now a Denver suburb, and died there April 23, 1907. When Anderson died in 1930, *The Post*'s brief obituary made no mention of the shooting.

The incident involving Bonfils took place during the happy holiday season of 1907. In a singularly uncharitable bit of timing, the News on the day before Christmas charged that Bonfils was a blackmailer who ought to be driven out of the community, out of business, or into the penitentiary. To emphasize the point, Bonfils was cartooned as Captain Kidd. The editor of the News and its sister paper, the Times, was Thomas Patterson, the same gentleman endorsed by The Post for U. S. senator seven years earlier. The News headline read: "F. G. Bonfils Slanders Businessmen Who Refuse to Be Bled." The secondary headline was: "Foiled in Blackmail Scheme. He Brands Citizens of Unimpeachable Character as Blacklegs and Gamblers." Among the passages in the story was this: ". . . While Bonfils' attack was couched in language that was incoherent to a degree—causing many of those who read it to declare it had been written by a man who was either drunk or insane—it was the most brutally frank demand for blackmail that has ever appeared in The Denver Post. . . ."

Obviously *The Post* held no monopoly on rhetoric. It is likely that Bonfils stewed over the editorial attack all through Christmas Day. The following morning Bonfils overtook Patterson near the corner of East Thirteenth Avenue and Logan Street as both were walking to work. Patterson testified in court that he heard someone say "Good morning," and when he turned to reply, he was punched in the face by Bonfils and knocked to the ground. Patterson was then sixty-five years old, Bonfils forty-seven. There was disagreement as to the number of blows struck, but Patterson said his upper plate was broken and his mouth cut. Passersby quickly restrained Bonfils as Patterson struggled to his feet.

There was also disagreement as to what was said by the two editors. One witness reported that as Patterson brushed the dust off his

clothes, he said, "You came up behind me and struck me like a coward without giving me any warning."

Bonfils allegedly replied, "You lie. I said, 'Good morning.'"

There are several versions as to what Bonfils said after that. One has Bonfils saying: "Good morning, Senator. So you're going to run me out of town, are you?"

Then, pow!

The other and more believable version: "You damned son of a bitch, I won't stand your abuse any longer."

In any event, Bonfils hurried to his office and wrote a bitter "So The People May Know" editorial which was published next day on page 1 over his signature. Here is the full text:

For twenty years Thomas M. Patterson has run amuck in this community-abusing, vilifying, slandering and libeling every citizen who has disagreed with him. According to this creature there can be no honest difference of opinion. Believe as I do-talk as I dodo as I do-or I will brand you as a thief, blackmailer or grafter. This is the proclamation of this man-and this is how he has applied it. The Supreme Court of Colorado rendered a decision that Patterson did not indorse—and he immediately slandered and libeled them until he was sentenced by this court for contempt and fined one thousand dollars. The policy of Gov. Henry Buchtel does not meet the approval of this man, and he vilifies the governor each day through his awful papers—exhuming old soldiers that have slept for years in the cemetery, and putting in the mouths of these dead men unspeakable lies and epithets against the Governor. Mayor Speer has run Denver according to his own policy, and Patterson daily slanders, vilifies, traduces and disgraces him-and so on down the long list. "You must agree with me and do as I do, or I will hound you out of the community," says Patterson. Having stood the vile assaults of this man until my patience was exhausted, I met him as I was walking to my office yesterday morning. An altercation ensued, during which Mr. Patterson received a well-merited thrashing. Insofar as I am concerned he may keep his tirade about other people—and I have no objection to his endeavor to create as much sympathy for himself as he may choose-but I also desire it understood that I will not sit idly by and allow him daily to abuse meeven though it may help him politically or otherwise, and whenever he does so I shall call him to account where I meet him.

F. G. Bonfils

The following day the *News* replied with a long editorial, two passages of which are significant:

... There is no mistake about what the language [of the *Post* editorial] implies. It is a threat, pure and simple, that whenever

anything concerning Bonfils, that he considers abuse, appears in the *News* or the *Times* he will assault Senator Patterson. There is difficulty about Bonfils' position: He is to be the judge of what is abuse. What is said may be as true as holy writ and affect the public in its most vital parts, yet he may consider it abuse. Then comes the attack. . . .

... If what the *Times* or the *News* has said about *The Post* proprietors is untrue, even a fraction of it, they have causes of action against Senator Patterson sufficient to impoverish him and to shut down the papers. . . .

Charges of assault and battery were brought against Bonfils and a trial was begun without delay before Judge Thomas Carlon. It turned out to be a strange hearing in which the altercation became secondary to the question of whether Bonfils was a blackmailer.

Probing for reasons behind the *News'* criticism of Bonfils, his attorney, John T. Bottom, asked Patterson, "And you have had objections to the manner in which he conducted his newspaper, is that the idea?"

Patterson replied: "Yes, sir. I have had objections, as all journalists should, to the style of journalism [of *The Post*] in dealing with men, the businessmen, with officials and with matters that affect the safety and morality of the people of Denver."

Bottom then asked, "In what way does that style differ from the style of conducting the News-Times?"

Patterson hesitated a moment, then replied, "In this, I have no question in the world but that Mr. Bonfils and Mr. Tammen have used the paper they control for blackmail purposes."

Bottom demanded specifics: "When if ever did *The Denver Post* or Mr. Bonfils blackmail anybody?"

Patterson said he did not want to mention names. Turning to Judge Carlon, Bottom declared it was imperative to his case that individuals be named. For years, he said, Patterson's newspapers had charged that *The Post* had blackmailed people and called Bonfils "a thief, a perjurer, a blackmailer."

"I say to your honor," Bottom continued, "if Senator Patterson said these things in his newspaper without having any foundation, then under all the laws of humanity this man had a right to meet him and to give him a thrashing, and he would not be a man if he didn't. And on the other hand, if Mr. Bonfils is a liar, a thief, a perjurer, and a blackmailer, then Senator Patterson had a right in his newspaper to say so.

"But there is an unwritten law that protects a man for making an

assault upon one who starts to rob him of a good name. I want to show by this witness [Patterson] that he gave this man [Bonfils] justification to assault him."

Under this kind of prodding Patterson replied: "I do not know of my own knowledge that they ever blackmailed anyone. My opinion that they were blackmailers was gathered from reading their paper and from common rumor."

Pressed for details, Patterson testified:

"The first I recall was the case of Edward Monash, who ran the Fair. He had been advertising in The Post. He concluded that he would advertise simply in the News, possibly in the News or the Times. Almost immediately upon that occurring The Post commenced a series of articles concerning Mr. Monash and the Fair, charging him with violating the child labor law, charging him with cruelties of every kind to the children in his employment, printing the most incendiary articles about Mr. Monash's management of the Fair. It brought Mr. Monash to terms, and Mr. Monash commenced to readvertise in The Post, and immediately every attack of that kind ceased."

Bottom summoned Monash as a rebuttal witness. This exchange followed:

Q—How long after the last of the articles with reference to child labor of the Fair were printed before you advertised in The Post?

I did a considerable amount of reading about William W. Anderson when I first became involved. Because I had been totally unaware of the history of the occupant at 2329 Eliot, I researched at the Western History Department of DPL and was amazed at how quickly the events of January 13, 1900 reached Colorado mining camps and newspapers in San Francisco and New York. I then wrote summaries and news articles to educate the community.

One of the sources of information was "Early Justice and the Formation of the Colorado Bar" from which these files above were copied. Anderson was acquitted and Tammen & Bonfils were cleared of their attempts to bribe the jury and the judge was threatened with disbarment. Such was 1900 law and order in early Colorado. I also found that few of the newcomers to Jefferson Park heard of Alfred Packer. But that's another story.

I sincerely believe designating 2329 Eliot as a Landmark is important to grounding the history of Colorado and educating us all in the early days of this great state and the Queen City of the Plains, Denver.

### Save the Anderson House Jefferson Park's Most Notable Tie to Colorado History

The House at 2329 Eliot Street is a prime example of Queen Anne architecture, steeped with 19<sup>th</sup> Century Denver History. The Landmark Preservation Commission has scheduled a public hearing on July 7, 2015 to consider its Preservation. Without their certification the home and adjacent bungalow will be demolished and replaced by 18 townhomes 40 feet high. Please consider the following historic events and support Preservation.

One hundred fifteen years ago, a well-respected Town of Highlands resident living at 2329 Eliot shot the two publishers of the Denver Evening Post. William W. Anderson, an attorney, in a dispute over the legal representation of Alferd Packer, pulled out his pistol in a brawl and shot Frederick G. Bonfils and Harry H. Tammen in their downtown Denver Post offices on January 13, 1900.


For those not familiar with Alferd G. Packer, he is known as the man-eating Cannibal of Colorado. He and five prospectors became snowbound in San Juan range in the Colorado Rockies. Packer is the only one who survived the winter. When he stumbled out into the Town of Saguache well fed, he was arrested and found guilty of killing, robbing and eating his companions; the judge was reputed to have charged he ate five of the seven Democrats in Hinsdale County.

This is the story of the rough and tumble frontier days in Denver which made news in every Colorado mining camp and in newspapers from San Francisco to New York for years. The publishers survived, to the chagrin of many. William W. Anderson was tried three times with two hung juries and finally was acquitted the third time in 1901 when it was clear Bonfils and Tammen had attempted to bribe the jury with women, whiskey and \$500. The publishers were indicted for jury tampering but acquitted due to "lack of evidence", for which the judge faced threats of disbarment. As for Alferd Packer he was finally paroled in 1901 by Governor Thomas. He lived out his days as a guard for the Denver Post and passed away in 1907 in Jefferson County.

The house on the hill at 2329 Eliot is historically important to Denver because of the people who owned the home and who lived there. Historic research shows Charles H. Walker, pastor of the Beth-Eden Baptist Church, platted Block 34 on June 10, 1886 and so it is named as his Subdivision. Walker sold Lots 24 & 25 on September 13, 1887 for \$1,000. It is believed the home was constructed about 1888 by Christopher C. Miller during a rapid expansion of streetcar lines to the suburbs. William W. Anderson and family lived in the home during the shooting and while his three trials unfolded in 1900 and 1901. He appears to have been a renter at that time, then moved away only to return in 1915 to purchase the home for \$2,500. During this period he owned homes immediately to the north and south, plus the artesian well in Carriage Lot 37. William W. Anderson, attorney-at-law lived there with his daughter and son-in-law until his death in January 1930.

Architecturally the house is significant as the only remaining intact examples of large two-story Queen Anne-style houses constructed in the Jefferson Park neighborhood. The carriage lot behind was the site of an artesian well once owned by the Town of Highlands. A streetcar line ran past 2329 Eliot, running from what is now west 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, crossing Federal Boulevard, turning left on Eliot and then turning right on 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue to downtown Denver. W.W. Anderson rode the streetcar that January day to his downtown law office in the Cooper Building. Before noon he walked across the street to the *Post* to meet with Bonfils & Tammen in what turned out to be a brawl. Anderson left, then returned with his equalizer .38 Smith & Wesson. Fortunately he was a poor shot.

You will see a yellow poster advising the Landmark Preservation Commission has scheduled a public hearing for Tuesday July 7, 2015 (LPC Hearing is postponed pending court decision on developer's lawsuit against the City). Our campaign for Landmark Designation of the Anderson House has been difficult. For the record, I am submitting copies of the September 8<sup>th</sup> JPUN "Vote" count to oppose Landmark Designation. If the developer, Nathan Adams states that JPUN voted to oppose the Designation, I will need to respond.

I will simply say the developer stacked the deck at the JPUN meeting by bringing in fellow contractors to vote. By our campaign we have proven without a doubt neighbors are in favor of Landmark Designation for 2329 Eliot.

I am attaching a copy of the JPUN attendance roster for September 8, 2015. It shows 7 individuals who list their Jefferson Park address at 2899 Speer Blvd. (Jae Edwards also registered at 2899) None of these contractors live in the City of Denver. All of them voted to oppose Designation. The 8<sup>th</sup> person is Nick Garcia who has a contract with Nathan Adams for 5 parking spaces in the proposed development of 18 townhomes.

I should also say this "vote" was not on the JPUN agenda. Adams asked to show a 4 minutes video of the property owner. Then he said, let's vote on it. All of us who are residents and JPUN Board members voted to abstain from taking a position as had been recommended by our Land Use Committee. Count was 9 oppose designation and 7 abstain from the issue.

Prior to this, Nathan Adams attempted to circumvent any Landmark Designation by timing Nick Garcia's withdrawal of his Designation Application 17 minutes before closing. Adams then received the Non-Historic permit at 4:18. He sued CPD for rescinding his permit. Judge Jones ruled on August 14, 2015 the City acted properly and allowed the Landmark process to continue. Here we are...again, this documentation is for the record.

### Why Preserve the Historic Anderson House?

### 1. The Anderson House brings to life the frontier west in Denver in 1900

The Anderson House at 2329 Eliot was the home of Denver attorney William W. Anderson who played an important role in the rough-and-tumble, turn-of the-century Denver. He sought to represent Alfred Packer, the Colorado Cannibal and in so doing crossed paths with the outrageous founders of the Denver Post, Harry Tammen and Frederick Bonfils. In a heated argument, the three wound up in fisticuffs over who was to represent Packer and secure his parole from prison. Anderson, belittled and bruised, pulled out his Smith & Weston and shot both Tammen and Bonfils twice. Both lived and Anderson was criticized for being such a poor shot. Anderson was tried twice resulting in hung juries and then was acquitted in his third trial when Harry Tammen among others were indicted and convicted for attempted bribery of the jury with "whiskey, women and \$500". Preserving the last 1880's Queen Anne home in Jefferson Park is important to understanding Denver's historic past. ### 2. The Anderson House is a pristine example of Queen Anne style architecture

The two-story house is an excellent example of Queen Anne style architecture popular in Denver from the 1870's to the 1890's and the last of its kind in Jefferson Park. With its hipped roof and protruding gables, the predominantly brick home rises from a rusticated stone foundation with an arched window and a prominent front gable, which accentuates an asymmetrical façade with a projecting front porch and decorative details painted in different colors. Built in 1886, the architectural style of Anderson House was popular in the Town of Highlands. However, the depression and silver crash of 1893 seemed to change the nature of the neighborhood. Many smaller homes were built and remain today. Today, without Landmark Designation, 2329 Eliot a pristine Queen Anne style home will be demolished. And to reiterate, this is the last remaining home with this style architecture in Jefferson Park.

This home will be reviewed by Denver's Landmark Preservation Commission on Tuesday, October 6, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. in the Webb building. Come to support preservation.
