6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable: This IGA will allow CDOT to use BR funds to reimburse the City for the construction for the reconstruction of two bridges, one at the Evergreen Golf Course and another structure in Red Rocks Park.

The City applied for and was granted Federal Bridge Replacement Funds in the amount of \$1,001,989. The CDOT Project Number assigned to this project is BRO M320-073, subaccount (WBS) number is 18375 (Red Rocks Park) and BRO M320-073, subaccount (WBS) 18436 (Evergreen Lake Park). The funds are available in the current fiscal year. The local matching funds by the City for FY 12 are estimated at \$351,497 (\$161,588 – 20% match plus \$100,00 overmatch for the Red Rocks bridge and \$88,909 – 20% match plus \$1,000 overmatch for the Evergreen lake Park bridge). This ordinance also establishes two capital grant fund number and appropriates \$1,001,989 to be received from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) towards the proposed reconstruction of the two park structures.

This ordinance will set up a capital grant fund and appropriate the budget for this grant as follows:
