The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) are co-funding road reconstruction and repair of the Blue Sky Highway/State Highway 5 through a Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) grant. The road requires significant repair where it travels through unstable wetlands near the top of Mt. Blue Sky. The road is located in Clear Creek County and traverses Denver Mountain Parks and US Forest Service land. Most of the work will take place on Denver-owned land within the boundary of Summit Lake Park (part of the Denver Mountain Parks system) where CDOT does not have an existing right of way. This Access & Use Permit Agreement authorizes FHWA and their contractor(s) to conduct road reconstruction and repair on Denver-owned land for the duration of the project. This agreement does not grant CDOT a permanent right of way. No further City funding is required for this project outside of limited staff time involved in planning, weekly meetings, monitoring, and restoration.
