Finance & Services

BR15- Adds \$200,000 to the contract with Airvac Services for a new total of 0296 \$650,000 for grease and sand trap maintenance (0531A0112).

BR15- Approves a supplemental budget appropriation to the Denver Sheriff 0305 Department to raise the salaries of members of the Sheriff Department's bargaining unit by 2.7%, which equates to an increase of \$1,802,271, as part of the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

BR15- Approves a \$1,334,276 contract with Denver Community Solar Garden I 0315 for solar energy for eight City facilities over a twenty-year term through 12-31-35 (GENRL-201521196-00).

BR15- Approves a \$1,334,276 contract with Denver Community Solar Garden II 0316 for solar energy for eight City facilities over a twenty-year term through 12-31-35 (GENRL-201521195-00).

BR15- Authorizes the Manager of Finance to provide financing through a 0352 capital lease purchase transaction on behalf of the Department of Aviation to purchase new technology services equipment for Denver International Airport in a principal amount not to exceed \$3,987,615 (PLANE-201521045-00).

Infrastructure & Culture

BR15- Vacates an alley at 2626 Lawrence Street for redevelopment as 0310 "Sustainability Park" in Council District 8.

BR15- Approves a \$1,107,294.21 contract with W.L. Contractors, Inc. to 0311 replace the existing traffic signal on the Evans Avenue bridge at Santa Fe Drive and the traffic sign bridge at South Platte River Drive south of Mississippi Avenue in Council District 7 (201520020).

RR15- Dedicates land as Lowell Boulevard near the intersection of West 52nd

0294 and Lowell Boulevard in Council District 1.

BR15-0340 Accepts and establishes a new capital grant fund and appropriation for a \$1,842,951 grant from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) for improvements to Denver's Westerly Creek from 33rd Avenue and the Confluence of Sand Creek in Council District 11.

BR15-0341 Approves a \$1,696,163.58 contract with Goodland Construction, Inc. to construct a seven acre mountain bike skills park and loop trail within Ruby Hill Park in Council District 7 (201520985).

BR15-0348 Accepts and establishes a new capital grant fund and appropriation for a \$1.5 million grant from the Colorado Department of Natural Resources for construction of the River Vision Implementation Plan (RVIP), including improvements to the South Platte River and Grant Frontier and Pasquinel's Landing Parks from West Iliff Avenue north to West Florida Avenue in Council District 7 (RM01312_004).

BR15-0349 Revokes Ordinance No. 35, Series of 2004, which granted a revocable permit to the Regional Transportation District to encroach into the right-of-way with a variety of items at 16th Street between Blake Street and Market Street in Council District 9.

BR15-0353 Vacates a 40 by 13 foot portion of the alley to the north of 3525 West 22nd Avenue in Council District 1.

BR15-0354 Vacates a portion of the area between 2345 7th Street and 695 Water Street in Council District 1.

BR15-0355 Vacates a portion of the right-of-way between 2345 7th Street and 695 Water Street in Council District 1.

BR15-0356 Vacates portions of the alley north, east, and south of the carriage lot with the address 2329 North Eliot Street in Council District 1.

BR15-0357 Vacates a remnant portion of right-of-way at West Wells Place between Tennyson Street and Utica Street that was unintentionally omitted from the previous application in Council District 1.

BR15-0358 Adds \$95,661 for a new total of \$584,395 to the contract with Humphries Poli Architects for additional design services for the McNichols Redevelopment Phase 2 project (201415818) in Council District 10.

Technology & Governance

BR15- Approves an agreement with Jackson Lewis, PC for \$1 million and

0293 through 9-30-15 to provide legal advice, assistance and representation with respect to discrimination issues to the Career Service Board and the City (201521249-00).

BR15- Approves a contract with Colorado Dental Service Inc., doing business as Delta Dental of Colorado Insurance Company for \$13,145,545.28 during 2015 for employee dental insurance benefits (CSAHR-2015-22024).

BR15- Approves a contract with UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company for \$54,430,112.00 during 2015 to provide medical insurance to eligible employees (CSAHR-2015-21976).

BR15- Amends a contract with Securus Technologies, Inc. for added services to the Inmate Phone system to allow for caller to leave a voicemail as well as friends and family to fund a call account. No change to contract amount (TECHS-201312032-01).
