The Scope of Work is for Professional Engineering Services necessary to complete final design activities, the development of construction bid documents, opinions of probable construction costs and processing of right-of-way clearances, environmental clearances, and utility clearances / agreements for three sets of improvements within the overall Broadway, Arizona to Exposition and I-25 Interchange Project. Specifically, the improvements are focused on the following project segments:

- 1) Broadway Kentucky to South of Tennessee Final Design
- 2) Broadway Mississippi to Arizona Project Final Design
- 3) NB I-25 Loop On-Ramp & Water Quality Pond Final Design

Final design activities include survey and right-of-way, geotechnical and pavement design, streetscape and landscape design, roadway design, utility coordination and design, traffic engineering, structural engineering, water quality analysis and design, environmental services, electrical and lighting design, construction phasing and traffic control, and public outreach.
