A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Risk Management Fund (SRF 11838) Fund for Department of Transportation and Infrastructure.

WHEREAS, the Department Of Transportation and Infrastructure (DOTI) is seeking approval for a capital equipment purchase of a vehicle to replace a vehicle totaled while in service; and

WHEREAS, said vehicle is critical to DOTI’s daily private development construction inspection needs; and

WHEREAS, the totaled vehicle will be replaced with a new Electric Vehicle; and

WHEREAS, said replacement vehicle has been approved by the Department of Finance (DOF), Risk Management Division to be purchased out of Special Revenue (11838); and

WHEREAS, capital equipment items with costs above the fifty-thousand-dollar threshold require City Council authorization;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Risk Management Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11838, the Chief Financial Officer, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

Electric Vehicle	1

The foregoing vehicle purchase will support DOTI operations.
