## FIRST AMENDATORY AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDATORY AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER, a municipal corporation of the State of Colorado (the "City") and HISTORICORPS, a Colorado nonprofit corporation (the "HistoriCorps"), jointly "the Parties"

## RECITALS

- **A.** The Parties entered into an Agreement executed September 21, 2017 (the "Agreement") for the performance of certain obligations set forth in that Agreement; and
  - **B.** The Parties wish to amend the Agreement to modify and extend the term date.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the parties hereby amend the Agreement as follows:

- **1.** Section 4.A. of the Agreement, entitled "Term" is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - "The term of this Agreement shall begin on the date of execution of this Agreement as signed by the Mayor of Denver, and shall terminate on September 21, 2027 ("Term"), unless sooner terminated pursuant to the terms of this Agreement."
- **2.** Except as herein amended, the Agreement is affirmed and ratified in each and every particular.
- 3. This First Amendatory Agreement will not be effective or binding on the City until it has been fully executed by all required signatories of the City and County of Denver, and if required by Charter, approved by the City Council.
