- The Sheriff Department has been applying for and receiving federal funds from the US Department of Justice since 1994 for the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (CFDA No. 16.606) This program is to reimburse states and localities for correctional officer salary costs incurred for holding undocumented criminal aliens who have at least one felony or two misdemeanor convictions for violation of state or local law, and who are incarcerated for at least 4 consecutive days during the reporting period. Justice Benefits helps the Denver Sheriff Department maximize the award granted to us through this program. As compensation for assisting us apply for the 2011 and 2012 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program, the Sheriff Department will pay Justice Benefits 8% of the total award.
