development ("CPD") for review after June 12, 2025 and on or before December 31, 2025 may continue to use the 2022 Denver building code ("2022 DBC") in its entirety, so long as the Building Code Permit Application does not expire based on 2022 Denver Building Code Section 131.2. No extensions of time will be granted beyond those allowed in 2022 DBC Section 131.2.

6 (2) For purposes of this subsection (c), a Building Code Permit Application will 7 be considered submitted to CPD when a set of complete construction documents 8 has been electronically provided by the applicant through the city's web-based 9 permitting portal. Construction documents means written, graphic, and pictorial 10 documents prepared or assembled for describing the design, location, and 11 physical characteristics of the elements of a project necessary for obtaining a 12 permit as set forth in 2025 Denver Commercial Building Code Section 133.

13(d) Effective date of the 2025 Denver fire code. Except as otherwise provided14below, the 2025 Denver Fire Code shall be effective on December 31, 2025.

(1) An application for a construction or operational permit required by the 2022
or 2025 Denver Fire Code ("Fire Code Permit Application") submitted to the
division of fire prevention for review after June 12, 2025 and on or before
December 31, 2025 may continue to use the 2022 Denver fire code in its entirety,
so long as the Fire Code Permit Application does not expire based on 2022 Denver
Fire Code Section 105.2.3. No extensions of time will be granted.

(2) For purposes of this subsection (d), a Fire Code Permit Application will be
considered submitted to the division of fire prevention when a set of complete
construction documents has been electronically provided by the applicant through
the city's web-based permitting portal. Construction documents mean written,
graphic, and pictorial documents prepared or assembled for describing the design,
location, and physical characteristics of the elements of a project necessary for
obtaining a permit as set forth in 2025 Denver Fire Code Section 106.
