The Colfax Mainstreet Coalition – a coalition between the City of Lakewood, DURA, and the City and County of Denver - was awarded a \$900,000 EPA Brownfields Assessment Grant in 2012 to conduct environmental assessments on behalf of developers seeking to redevelop properties along the Colfax Corridor that are may have become contaminated due to prior land uses, e.g. historical gas stations and drycleaners, which has prevented the properties from being redeveloped.
