5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved

a. Scope of Work

This is an amendment request for the contract langugage. On pg. 3 (item 1.d) the contract states that DBS will submit reimbursement requests at 80% of the project costs and DBS will pay 20%. While DBS will pay the Local Match portions of the project, the funding ratios are different between the two tasks (Task 1: bicycles and Task 2: stations as shown in Exhibit 3). As well, the City needs to pay DBS 100% to receive the maximum reimbursement from CDOT. At the completion of the project, DBS will reimburse the City for any Local Match and Local Agency Overmatch on the two tasks. The amendment clarifies this reimbusement language on pg. 3 (item 1.d) to match the funding schedule breakdown. There is not affect to scope of work or overall budget.

The Denver B-cycle Downtown Core and Neighborhood Expansion project will include the planning, purchase and installation of 27 public bike sharing stations, 150 bicycles and associated hardware and software. The bike stations will expand the existing system by approximately 50% and is expected to multiply ridership by 212%. Use of certain public rights of way for the placement of some bike stations is contemplated, subject to Denver's regular requirements. Denver Bike Sharing will provide project management and all necessary staff support to complete the project. The City will provide project management oversight and inspection.
