5.	This request is a non-competitive direct negotiation agreement for a Peer-To-Peer Car Share Permit between Turo, Inc. (Turo) and Denver International Airport (DEN). Turo will operate a peer-to-peer car sharing platform at DEN to connect airport customers with individual owners engaged in a car sharing operation. The company shall not facilitate shared car transfers to shared car drivers at any locations except those designated by the DEN Chief Executive Officer (CEO), and/or at Turo's off-airport facilities. Turo shall remit 10% of the gross revenues received from transactions to DEN. The revenue projection was established by forecasting 8% year over year growth over the term of the agreement.
