8 **For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the Community Development Special**
9 **Revenue Fund for the “Housing Stability Private Grants” program.**
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12 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Housing Stability (HOST) was created in 2019 to manage
13 the City’s programs and services that are dedicated to individuals experiencing homelessness and
14 other housing challenges; and

15 **WHEREAS**, HOST desires an additional Special Revenue Fund to administer private
16 grants;

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**
19 **DENVER:**

21 **Section 1.** A new fund is hereby established in the Community Development Special
22 Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 16000, a “Housing Stability Private Grants” Fund, Accounting No.
23 16609, for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of private grants.

24 **Section 2.** Monies received from private grants shall be deposited into the Treasury of the
25 City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 16000, which is set forth and described in Section
26 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.


27 **Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Housing Stability Private Grants”
28 Fund, Accounting No. 16609, in the amount not to exceed the amounts awarded as described in
29 Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Department of
30 Housing Stability or his or her designate or other authorized officials. This Fund is sponsor-funded
31 and non-lapsing.

32 **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
33 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
34 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
