5 **A BILL**

6 **For an ordinance modifying Chapter 18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the**
7 **City and County of Denver to allow contributions to the health maintenance**
8 **organization (HMO) benefit plan to be implemented in 2021.**

9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

10 **Section 1.** That Subsection (d) of the Revised Municipal Code section 18-173 is hereby
11 deleted and restated as follows:

12 **Sec. 18-173. – Definitions**



13 (d) *Deductible Health Maintenance Organization (DHMO) and Health Maintenance*
14 *Organization (HMO) contributions and payments.* The city shall contribute the following for DHMO
15 plans and HMO plans, regardless of the insurance provider selected:

16 (1) Full-time contributions shall be: Eighty-four percent (84%) of the monthly
17 premium for employee-only plans; seventy-nine percent (79%) of the monthly premium for
18 employee plus children plans; seventy-six and one-half percent (76.5%) of the monthly
19 premium for employee plus spouse plans; and seventy-four percent (74%) of the monthly
20 premium for family plans.

21 (2) Part-time contributions. The city shall contribute an amount equal to one-half
22 (½) of the full-time contribution rate for each category of coverage listed in DRMC section
23 18-173(d)(1).

24 **Section 2.** Effective date. This bill takes effect January 1, 2021.
