I. DEPARTMENTAL MATTERS IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF BUSINESS:

A. Mayor's Office - Anthony Aragon

RR13-0646 Approves the Mayoral reappointments of Louise Boris, Shawn Cohn, Henry Jackson, and Nikki Johnson to the Crime Prevention and Control Commission for terms effective immediately and expiring on September 1, 2016, or until a successor is duly appointed.

B. Arts & Venues Denver - Amy Lindsey

BR13-0647 Approves the final payment of \$320,243.26 with Proxy Partners and extends the contract to November 30, 2013, when a new provider chosen by bid will assume the functions of the contract (CE26001).

C. Denver International Airport - Amy Raaz

BR13-0649 Approves a lease agreement with US Airways, Inc. for two preferential gates, support space, and the right to use facilities at Denver International Airport to support the airlines operations (201206587).

BR13-0650 Adds \$400,000 and two years to the contract with RTL Networks, Inc. for on-call technology services at the airport (CE-15008).

D. Finance - Laurel Delmonico

BR13-0651 Appropriates \$554,753 to the Denver Preschool Program special revenue fund to reconcile the estimated preschool program sales and use tax revenues to the actual revenues received in 2012.

E. Human Services - Ron Mitchell

BR13-0648 Approves an amendment to accept \$300,000 for the 2013-2014 Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program (HVRP) grant from the U.S. Department of Labor bringing the total award to \$600,000 for homeless veterans services (2012-07107-01).

F. Office of Economic Development - Seneca Holmes

BR13-0652 Approves a \$976,910 contract with Rocky Mountain Human Services (formerly Denver Options, Inc.) for training and employment services (OEDEV: 201311612).

G. Office of Emergency Management - Scott Field

BR13-0653 Approves an amendment to the contract with Federal Signal Corporation for \$78,000 to add nine additional sirens to the City's Outdoor Public Warning System for coverage improvement and integration into the existing activation system (MOOEM201205697).

H. Public Works - Nancy Kuhn/Mark Guerrero

- BR13-0654 Vacates an alley bounded by Blake, Walnut, 28th and 29th streets to help reduce litter, graffiti, and dumping, after determining the alley is not needed for access, service, or transportation, in Council District 9.
- BR13-0655 Vacates the portion of alley dedicated by Ordinance No. 166, Series of 1987, being the northwesterly 4.5 feet of the alley in block 62, Harmans Subdivision, bounded by Columbine and Clayton streets and E. 3rd and E. 2nd avenues, for an underground garage as part of redevelopment in District 10.
- BR13-0656 Approves a \$1,424,013, 123-day contract with Mark Young Construction for replacement of spotlight booths and concession stands in Red Rocks Amphitheater.
