A BILL

For an ordinance making a supplemental appropriation in the Denver Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, Denver Arts and Venues is experiencing increased costs, including cleaning and janitorial services, film and theater production support services, public order and safety services, security and personal safety services, and ticketing and credit card Fees; and

WHEREAS, expenditures will be offset by revenue and will result in a net zero change in the agency’s year-end fund balance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Denver Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15000 not otherwise appropriated and in addition to amounts heretofore appropriated by Ordinance No. 1682, Series of 2023, and any supplemental appropriations or rescissions, there is hereby appropriated to the appropriation accounts hereinafter designated the amount of money following such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
