A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing capital equipment purchases from the Denver Public Library Special Revenue Fund (15830) Fund.

WHEREAS, the Denver Public Library (DPL) is seeking approval for the capital equipment purchase of two (2) bookmobiles to provide expanded book mobile services to communities impacted by the closure of four DPL branch locations in 2025-2026 due to bond renovation projects; and

WHEREAS, the primary focus of said vehicles will be the Southeast Denver area, closest to where the four temporarily closed branches are located; and

WHEREAS, said vehicles will be purchased from the Denver Public Library Fund Special Revenue Fund (15830); and

WHEREAS, because this is a capital equipment purchase above the fifty-thousand-dollar threshold, DPL requires City Council authorization to purchase said vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Denver Public Library Fund Special Revenue Fund (Accounting No. 15830), the City Librarian, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

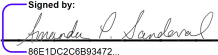
The foregoing vehicle purchases are to support the operations of the Denver Public Library.
