### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY (if applicable)**

- Fund and Organization Number, including Grant Number if known: 17405/0117101
- The grantor, grant amount, and start/end dates: The grantor is the U.S. Department of Human Services; the funds are provided to Denver's Department of Human Services through the Colorado Department of Human Services. Through an MOU, DHS provides these funds to Denver Workforce Services (OED). The appropriation request of \$1,767,520 is for period of performance from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.
- CFDA Number and Contract Control Number: 93.558
- **Grant objectives (e.g. target population, geographic area served):** The purpose of these funds is to reduce the number of Denver families in poverty by providing employment and training services to TANF participants and to TANF-eligible individuals, thereby increasing work participation and improving the chances for self-sufficiency.
- Matching dollar amounts and staffing requirements, and the funding source of the match: None
- **Evaluation component**: Work participation rates are measured monthly; additionally, performance standards such as entered employment rate and wages are applied and tracked through JobLink, the State's MIS system.
- For multiple year projects, list previous accomplishments: Created tier system for participants and Denver Workforce Services will solely work with those deemed work ready, whereas DHS and local providers will provide more intensive services for the tiers ranked below Tier 1.

The Office of Economic Development/Denver Workforce Services is requesting \$1,767,520 as funding for the delivery of the PY17/18 TANF Employment and Training Program.

#### Background

Since 1999, the Department of Human Services (DHS) has been responsible for the eligibility determination and case management services provided to Denver's TANF participants. OED/DWS, through a Memorandum of Understanding with DHS, had been responsible for the employment and training program of TANF participants as part of its annual budget request.

## <u>Budget</u>

The amount to be budgeted for the TANF program for spending by OED/DWS is \$1,767,520 for the period July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018.
