6. **General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:**

The proposed ordinance is intended to provide payment to Insight to pay for the first year payment for the Microsoft Enterprise Agreement covering the period of March 1, 2014 through February 29, 2015 for the amount of \$792,118.11.

The Microsoft EA provides the City entitlement to new patches, fixes, enhancements, and releases for the Microsoft Enterprise Agreement products covered. Note that Microsoft now requires that we purchase at minimum the Core CAL (Client Access License) products: Windows Server, Exchange Server, SCCM, Lync and SharePoint. Each City employee who uses a computer must have each Core CAL item assigned to him or her. This is the first year payment and note that this is a 3 year agreement. Prices for Microsoft EA items remain in effect for 3 years.
