A BILL

For an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund Series to make a cash transfer to the Parks Legacy Capital Improvement Funds.

WHEREAS, in 2018, Denver voters approved Ballot Measure 2A, which increased the sales tax rate by 0.25 percentage points starting January 1, 2019, to be spent on various programs and projects that support Parks, Trails and Open Space: and

WHEREAS, because of supply chain issues, vacancies, and unspent operational funds from 2019 through 2022, the Parks Legacy Special Revenue Fund has accrued savings; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) has identified legacy eligible projects with budget gaps primarily driven by escalating construction costs; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to transfer savings from the Parks Legacy SRF to Parks Legacy Capital Project Funds to maintain scope of work for current projects and not delay projects due to escalating costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15000, listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the Parks Legacy Capital Improvement Fund:
