A BILL

For an ordinance rescinding budget, transferring cash and making appropriations in the General Fund, General Government and Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Funds and Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund of moneys designated by City Council for various projects.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:
