Denver Office of Strategic Partnerships (DOSP) was created in January 2004 to serve as a liaison between the City of Denver and the nonprofit sector and is supported by a 13 person Mayoral appointed Commission.







#### **DOSP Mission & Vision**

Mission: To serve as a catalyst to leverage the best of Denver's public and nonprofit sectors to engage in innovative and collaborative work

Vision: To create a stronger community through government and nonprofit partnerships







#### **Challenges in the Sector**

Limited (and shrinking) resources – Decreases in direct funding and increases in cost of doing business

Shifting role of government – Trend towards moving social supports out of public sector

Increased social responsibility – Increased focus on measurable social impact







#### **The DOSP Response**

**Programs** – "Back to basics" capacity building; collaboration, engagement and partnership work; innovation pipeline; and volunteer infrastructure

**Policies** – Lease back-stop/incentives for innovative mixed-use, community reinvestment strategies, etc.

**Research** – Economic impact study
