A BILL

For an ordinance approving a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Regional Transportation District, relating to the 35th Street Pedestrian Bridge and relocation of the UPRR Yard Office.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Regional Transportation District, in the words and figures contained and set forth in that form of Intergovernmental Agreement available in the office and on the webpage of City Council, and to be filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, on November 5, 2014, under City Clerk's Filing No. 2014-0920, is hereby approved.
