6. General description/background of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

In 1996, City Council approved the St. Luke's Urban Redevelopment Plan and authorized the use of property and sales tax increment revenues. The plan is intended to promote, among other things, improved traffic within the Urban Redevelopment Area and authorizes the installation, construction and reconstruction of any public improvements including streets, sidewalks, alleys and underground facilities. Pursuant to a study conducted by the City in cooperation with DURA, the parties have determined the City should undertake the complete design and construction of two-way street conversions relating to the St. Luke's Urban Redevelopment Area with pedestrian, bicycle and transit enhancements. This includes signal construction, curb line adjustments, and restriping of pavement markings. The project area includes 19th and 20th Avenues between Broadway and Park Avenue and related cross-streets between 18th and 20th Avenues.

This ordinance will set up a capital grant fund and appropriate the budget for this grant as follows:
