24-0266 Approves the loan agreement with SCI-Capitol City, LLC. in the amount of \$2,600,000 to assist with the acquisition of the Property, which will operate as a mobile home park with sixty (60) mobile home spaces being used as affordable housing units, in Council District 3 (HOST-202472389). 24-0267 Approves a loan agreement with Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver, Inc., in the amount of \$900,000 to assist with the finance costs associated with the development of eight (8) income-restricted homeownership affordable units, which will be known as Augustana Townhomes, in Council District 5 (HOST-202370649).
