5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:

This approves a contract with LAZ Parking Midwest, LLC to provide shuttle services at Denver International Airport (DEN). This includes but is not limited to providing service to all Landside Employee and Shuttle Parking Lots, Airside Employee Parking Lot, as well as routes deemed necessary by DEN for emergency situations or irregular operations. This contract increases employee wages and benefits while overall significantly reducing costs to DEN and ensuring the contract remains consistent over a decade to maximize the use of assets by DEN.

This contract is a cost-plus structure, where DEN will do a direct reimbursement of costs incurred by the contractor, this includes the procurement of up to 65 compressed natural gas (CNG) powered, 40-foot buses, plus an annual Management Fee. This "costs-plus" model is a cost-effective model for DEN, but most importantly, provides the contractor's employees a livable wage (for a Commercial Driver Licensed (CDL) level position \$29 per hour versus the average of \$22.50 per hour).

The contract is for \$371,098,983.41 and the term is seven (7) years three (3) one-year options to extend.

This includes but is not limited to providing service to all Landside Parking Lots, Airside Employee Services as well as routes deemed necessary. The contractor will (1) manage, operate, maintain, provide the vehicles, and other related services that are required for a Comprehensive Shuttle Bus Service at the Airport, (2) ensure compliance with all applicable laws, rules, regulations, and standards for busing operations, and (3) establish and maintain superior levels of customer service. The bus fleet will be equipped with state-of-the-art technology that allows LAZ and its clients to track vehicles in real time, monitor driver behavior, digitally monitor vehicle mechanical status.
