A BILL

For an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Revenue Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Colorado Department of Human Services, Behavioral Health Administration, to provide funds for substance use disorder, mental health treatment, jail medicated assisted treatment and pre-sentence re-entry to Denver city jails, citywide.
