- A. The Project will initially focus on: 1) youth that are arrested, do not screen to Level 1 Secure Detention, do not require treatment in a Qualified Residential Treatment Program (QRTP), and cannot go home, and/or 2) youth that are arrested and ordered by the court to have a placement and service evaluation after the detention hearing (Eligible Youth). Eligible Youth not in county custody, will remain in their parent's/guardian's custody and need authorization for their stay in the assessment bed. Douglas County will be responsible for ensuring Savio House and Shiloh House's performance of these services in accordance with the terms of their respective Contracts.
