Amends a contract with Container Pros, LLC by adding \$1,305,146.08 for a new total of \$1,761,298.76 and 8 months for a new end date of 12-31-2023 to continue supporting the volume-based trash pricing program by exchanging trash carts citywide to match each households' requested cart size, as well as continue to deliver curbside compost carts and kitchen counter compost pails (202265382-02/202367311-02). Approves a revenue sharing agreement with TeamFun, Inc. for \$20,000 in guaranteed annual minimum payment, plus 11.5% of revenue above that amount and through 3-8-2026 to provide concession services at Washington Park in Council District 6 and City Park in Council District 9 (202367187). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 5-15-2023. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-11-2023.

<u>23-0390</u> A resolution approving a proposed Concession License Agreement between the City and County of Denver and SkiEcho, LLC to provide mobile food truck services at Echo Lake Lodge.

Approves a revenue sharing license agreement with SkiEcho, LLC for a site fee of \$125 per week plus 11% of monthly revenue and through 12-31-2023, plus two 1-year options to extend, to operate a mobile food truck serving park visitors during the temporary closure of Echo Lake Lodge (PARKS-202266017). Amends a purchase order with CLNC Enterprises, LLC, doing business as La Machaca, by adding \$775,000 for a new total of \$3,455,000 and 3 months for a new end date of 5-31-2023 to provide meals for guests staying at emergency shelters serving migrants while a new procurement process is completed, citywide (PO-00124808). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 5-15-2023. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-12-2023.

<u>23-0385</u> A resolution approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and La Raza Services, Inc. to support youth behavioral health services and provide counseling, mental wellness, and other wrap-around programming, citywide.

Approves a contract with La Raza Services, Inc., doing business as Servicios de la Raza, Inc., for \$1,000,000 and through 12-31-2024 to expand behavioral health services for approximately 200 youth ages 11-25 by hiring four new staff positions to support youth behavioral health services and providing counseling, mental wellness, and other wrap-around programming, citywide (MOEAI-202367315). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 5-15-2023. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-12-2023.

23-0469 A resolution authorizing and approving the expenditure and payment from the appropriation account designated "liability claims," the total sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars an no cents (\$25,000.00), payable to Lampert & Walsh, LLC COLTAF, in full payment and satisfaction of all claims related to the civil action captioned *Neema Hawazi v. Alexis Koo, Denver Fire Department d/b/a City and County of Denver* which was filed in the District Court, City and County of Denver, Colorado, Case No. 2022CV32911.

<u>23-0387</u> A bill for an ordinance enacting Article XI of Chapter 28 to create the Denver Construction Careers Program.

Amends Chapter 28 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code by adding a new Article XI Workforce Development Requirements in City Construction to create the Denver Construction Careers Program to address construction labor shortages through apprenticeship training requirements and employment opportunities for people living in economically disadvantaged areas or experiencing economic disadvantage. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-12-2023.

23-0388 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Public Schools, to administer the Denver Youth Employment Program.

Approves an intergovernmental agreement with Denver Public Schools for \$1,500,000 and through 12-31-2023 to administer the Denver Youth Employment Program to provide customized workforce development services, including year-round programming and summer internships for approximately 375 eligible Denver youth, citywide (OEDEV-202366654-00). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 5-15-2023. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-12-2023.

23-0377 A bill for an ordinance designating certain properties as being required for public use and authorizing use and acquisition thereof by negotiation or through condemnation proceedings of fee simple, easement and other interests, including any rights and interests related or appurtenant to properties designated as needed for the installment of Phase 1 of the 48th Avenue Greenway (Outfall) project on 48th Avenue from Emerson Street continuing west to Washington Street. This includes easement interests, access rights, improvements, buildings, fixtures, licenses, and permits as part of the Project.

Grants the authority to acquire through negotiated purchase or condemnation of all or any portion of any property interest as needed in support of the 48th Avenue Greenway Outfall Project, including easement interests, access rights, improvements, buildings, fixtures, licenses, permits and other appurtenances, located at 48th Avenue from Emerson Street to Washington Street in Council District 9. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-11-2023.

23-0378 A bill for an ordinance granting the authority to acquire through negotiated purchase or condemnation of all or any portion of any property interest as needed for the first phase of the Globeville Levee Improvements Project, located along the west bank of the South Platte River from East 50th Avenue to North of Westbound Interstate 70, in Council District 9.

Grants the authority to acquire through negotiated purchase or condemnation of all or any portion of any property interest as needed in support of the Globeville Levee Improvements Project, including easement interests, access rights, improvements, buildings, fixtures, licenses, permits and other appurtenances, located along the west bank of the South Platte River from East 50th Avenue to North of Westbound I-70 in Council District 9. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-11-2023.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure Committee

<u>23-0373</u> A bill for an ordinance amending Chapter 54 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code to regulate and enforce the parking of vehicles, including large vehicles and vehicle junkers, in the public right-of-way.

Amends Chapter 54 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code to create new curbside and parking enforcement mechanisms to address emerging safety and space management issues, citywide. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-11-2023.

<u>23-0374</u> A bill for an ordinance amending the Denver Zoning Code, concerning relief processes of zoning standards.

Approves a Denver Zoning Code text amendment to create new administrative adjustment and variance procedures. If ordered published, a public hearing will be held on Monday, 5-22-2023. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-11-2023.

23-0375 A bill for an ordinance amending Chapter 59 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code, concerning relief processes of zoning standards.

Amends Chapter 59 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code to allow properties that retain zoning designation under Former Chapter 59 or that need to comply with state or federal law, access to the text amendment approved in CB23-0374. If ordered published, a public hearing will be held on Monday, 5-22-2023. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-11-2023.

<u>23-0384</u> A bill for an ordinance designating 602 South Harrison Lane as a structure for preservation.

Approves an individual landmark designation for a structure located at 602 South Harrison Lane in Council District 10. If ordered published, a public hearing will be held on Monday, 5-15-2023. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-11-2023.

23-0355 A bill for an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund Series to make a cash transfer to the Parks Legacy Capital Improvement Funds.

Rescinds \$6,593,500 from the Parks Legacy Operating Special Revenue Fund (15828) and authorizes a cash transfer to the Parks Legacy Capital Improvement Funds (36045 and 36050) and appropriates the transferred amount to support escalating construction costs for multiple Parks projects, citywide. 23-0348 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Project Partnership Agreement between the City and County of Denver and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, to establish project outputs, cost sharing and cost reimbursement criteria, and general conditions for the South Platte River and Tributaries Program in Council Districts 1, 3, 6, 7, and 9.

Approves an intergovernmental project partnership agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to establish project outputs, cost sharing and cost reimbursement criteria, and general conditions for the South Platte River and Tributaries Program in Council Districts 1, 3, 6, 7, and 9 (202367390). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 5-8-2023. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-4-2023.

Safety, Housing, Education & Homelessness Committee

23-0344 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Fourth Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and University of Colorado Hospital Authority for continued emergency provision of financial assistance to individuals living with HIV / AIDS.

Amends an intergovernmental agreement with University of Colorado Hospital Authority (UCHA) by adding \$17,250 for a new total of \$2,203,321 for continued medical case management, mental health, substance abuse outpatient care, outpatient/ambulatory health and early intervention services to individuals living with HIV/AIDS in the Denver Transitional Grant Area, citywide. No change to contract duration (202158736-04/ 202366533-04). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 5-8-2023. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-5-2023.

23-0345 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Fourth Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Health and Hospital Authority, to continue providing care, treatment, and supportive services to individuals living with HIV/AIDS.

Amends an intergovernmental agreement with Denver Health and Hospital Authority by adding \$17,250 for a new contract total of \$2,242,607 to continue providing care, treatment, and supportive services to individuals living with HIV/AIDS in the Denver Transitional Grant Area, citywide. No change to contract duration (202366661-04). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 5-8-2023. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 4-5-2023.
